

Public Masses Suspended / Remote Parish Operations During COVID-19 Health Crisis

Bishop Barber, in response to the Mandatory Shelter in Place order from the Contra Costa County Health Officer has suspended all public Masses. Additionally, the office and church will be closed beginning Tuesday March 17th until April 7th.

Although there will be no public Mass, Mass will be celebrated privately in the church everyday for all outstanding Mass intentions.

Also, the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick will be available for anyone who is in serious need of it. Call this emergency line: 510-259-8706.

Confession is still available by appointment with our priests.

St. Vincent de Paul is still available feeding the needy.

All events, meetings or activities are canceled until April 7th.
