“In the Name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit”

The prayers of the Church, including the mass and sacraments, begin with the affirmation of the Holy Trinity. Our catechism teaches us, “There is one God, who has three Persons, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Each Person is God, yet there is still only one God” (CCC #234, #253-256). We have the Father Who is the Creator, the Son Who is the Redeemer, and the Holy Spirit Who is the Sanctifier and the Counselor.

The word Trinity is not written in the Sacred Scriptures. Still, it is present in all major feasts and solemnities we celebrate, such as Christmas, Epiphany, Good Friday, Easter, Ascension, and Pentecost. The truth of the Trinity, the Triune God, the Three but One God, reminds and challenges us to live a life of communion, where charity bonds us with one another and with God. We make the Sign of the Cross when we bless ourselves by invoking the God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit. We should be aware that doing so entails the responsibility of living what the Trinity teaches.

Is the Trinity real? Is our God One but Three Persons? In the New Testament (of the Sacred Scriptures), several passages clearly express the doctrine of the Trinity. On the baptism of Jesus by John the Baptist, we find the Three Persons of our One God. “After Jesus was baptized, he came up from the water and behold, the heavens were opened [for him], and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove [and] coming upon him. A voice came from the heavens, saying, this is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased” (Mt. 3: 16-17). The other one is in the preaching mission given by the risen Lord to the disciples. Jesus commands them to baptize people. “Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit” (Mt 28:19).

Can we make the Trinity real in our lives? How? When we begin to see that everyone, including ourselves, is the temple of the Holy Spirit where all three persons abide and allow respect to live and grow, we then live a life inspired by the Trinity. We see within the Trinity the mutual respect. When we do the same, we translate the truth that they teach us in our lives. Also, when we allow love and unity to be at work within our family, in our workplaces, and our relationship with one another, we become members of God’s trinitarian family. Whenever there is Trinity, there is charity. Whenever we live a life in charity, we profess our faith in God, who is Three but One.

Saint Augustine said, “You see the Trinity if you see love.” We do our best to live in love with our cooperation to the graces we receive. Thus, we live our lives patterned in love found in the Trinity.

En el Nombre del Padre y del Hijo y del Espíritu Santo”

Las oraciones de la Iglesia, incluyendo la misa y los sacramentos, comienzan con la afirmación de la Santísima Trinidad. Nuestro catecismo nos enseña: “Hay un solo Dios, que tiene tres Personas, Padre, Hijo y Espíritu Santo. Cada Persona es Dios, pero todavía hay un solo Dios” (CIC #234, #253-256). Tenemos al Padre que es el Creador, al Hijo que es el Redentor y al Espíritu Santo que es el Santificador y el Consejero.

La palabra Trinidad no está escrita en las Sagradas Escrituras. Aún así, está presente en todas las fiestas y solemnidades importantes que celebramos, como Navidad, Epifanía, Viernes Santo, Pascua, Ascensión y Pentecostés. La verdad de la Trinidad, el Dios Triuno, el Dios Tres pero Uno, nos recuerda y nos desafía a vivir una vida de comunión, donde la caridad nos une unos con otros y con Dios. Hacemos la Señal de la Cruz cuando nos bendecimos invocando a Dios Padre, Dios Hijo y Dios Espíritu Santo. Debemos ser conscientes de que hacerlo conlleva la responsabilidad de vivir lo que enseña la Trinidad.

Es real la Trinidad? ¿Es nuestro Dios Uno sino Trino en Personas? En el Nuevo Testamento (de las Sagradas Escrituras), varios pasajes expresan claramente la doctrina de la Trinidad. En el bautismo de Jesús por Juan el Bautista, encontramos las Tres Personas de nuestro Dios Único. “Después de que Jesús fue bautizado, subió del agua y he aquí, los cielos se abrieron [para él], y vio al Espíritu de Dios que descendía como paloma [y] venía sobre él. Vino una voz de los cielos que decía: Este es mi Hijo amado, en quien tengo complacencia” (Mt 3, 16-17). El otro está en la misión de predicación dada por el Señor resucitado a los discípulos. Jesús les ordena que bauticen a las personas. “Id, pues, y haced discípulos a todas las naciones, bautizándolos en el nombre del Padre y del Hijo y del Espíritu Santo” (Mt 28, 19).

¿Podemos hacer real la Trinidad en nuestra vida? ¿Cómo? Cuando comenzamos a ver que todos, incluyéndonos a nosotros mismos, somos el templo del Espíritu Santo donde moran las tres personas y permitimos que el respeto viva y crezca, entonces vivimos una vida inspirada por la Trinidad. Vemos dentro de la Trinidad el respeto mutuo. Cuando hacemos lo mismo, traducimos la verdad que nos enseñan en nuestras vidas. Además, cuando permitimos que el amor y la unidad actúen dentro de nuestra familia, en nuestros lugares de trabajo y en nuestra relación unos con otros, nos convertimos en miembros de la familia trinitaria de Dios. Siempre que hay Trinidad, hay caridad. Siempre que vivimos una vida de caridad, profesamos nuestra fe en Dios, que es Tres pero Uno.

San Agustín dijo: “Ves la Trinidad si ves el amor”. Hacemos todo lo posible para vivir en amor con nuestra cooperación a las gracias que recibimos. Por lo tanto, vivimos nuestras vidas modeladas en el amor que se encuentra en la Trinidad.


