Dear Friends in Christ,

The Corpus Christi is the feast at the very center and heart of our Church, of our faith and our lives. This Solemnity reminds us of the Mass we attend every day or every week. What is your true motive of going to Mass? We often hear this, especially from young folks: Mass is so long and boring. I don't get anything out of it. I tell you: "If you say the Mass is long, it is because your love

is short!" If you say the Mass is boring, because you are bored. People say Mass is boring because they miss the point of going to Mass, because the center point of Mass is worship and the heart of every worship is sacrifice. Worship has nothing to do with what we can get something out of it. It is completely about what we can give to God. We come to give God ourselves. As we bring the gifts to the altar, we also place ourselves on it, saying Lord, please receive me as well. The goal is not to get anything out of it. The goal is to offer to God the best of who we are.

But as human beings, sometimes we may feel bored at Mass. That's ok, because what is boring to you, does not mean it is boring to God. We do not worship an experience. We worship a Reality. If you say I don't feel like going to Mass, that's is to say I am not interested in worshipping God. I am worshipping myself. But it does not have to be that way. You and I are invited to Mass which is the most powerful form of worship that God has ever given to his people. At Mass we offer the sacrifice of the Son to the Father and we offer up our very self. We give without expecting anything in return. That is the right approach to Mass. In order to spend a good quality time with God, I would recommend you the followings: **1- Read before hand the Sunday Readings. 2- Go to Mass on time. 3 - Be attentive/ participate in the Mass. 4- Receive Holy Communion in the state of grace. 5- Don't talk too loud in church. 6- Attend the whole Mass. 7- Always leave the Church with some takeaways to live out for the week.** Again, the heart of every religion is worship. The heart of every worship is sacrifice. So go to Mass and enjoy it, for we do not worship an experience but a Reality-Jesus Christ. At communion, we do not receive something, but Someone – the Bread of Life, the source of salvation. Amen!

El Corpus Christi es la fiesta en el centro y corazón mismo de nuestra Iglesia, de nuestra fe y de nuestra vida. Esta Solemnidad nos recuerda la Misa a la que asistimos todos los días o todas las semanas. ¿Cuál es su verdadero motivo para ir a Misa? A menudo escuchamos esto, especialmente de los jóvenes: la misa es tan larga y aburrida. No saco nada de eso. Os digo: "¡Si decís que la Misa es larga, es porque vuestro amor es breve!". Si dices que la Misa es aburrida, es porque estás aburrido. La gente dice que la Misa es aburrida porque pierden el sentido de ir a Misa, porque el punto central de la Misa es la adoración y el corazón de cada adoración es el sacrificio. La adoración no tiene nada que ver con lo que podamos obtener de ella. Se trata completamente de lo que podemos dar a Dios. Venimos a darnos a Dios nosotros mismos. Mientras llevamos las ofrendas al altar, también nos colocamos sobre él, diciendo Señor, por favor, recíbeme también a mí. El objetivo no es sacar nada de ello. El objetivo es ofrecer a Dios lo mejor de lo que somos.

Pero como seres humanos, a veces podemos sentirnos aburridos en la Misa. Eso está bien, porque lo que es aburrido para ti, no significa que sea aburrido para Dios. No adoramos una experiencia. Adoramos una Realidad. Si dices que no tengo ganas de ir a misa, eso quiere decir que no estoy interesado en adorar a Dios. Me estoy adorando a mí mismo. Pero no tiene que ser así. Usted y yo estamos invitados a la Misa, que es la forma de adoración más poderosa que Dios le ha dado a su pueblo. En la Misa ofrecemos el sacrificio del Hijo al Padre y nos ofrecemos a nosotros mismos. Damos sin esperar nada a cambio. Ese es el enfoque correcto de la misa. Para pasar un buen tiempo con Dios, te recomiendo lo siguiente: **1- Leer de antemano las lecturas del domingo. 2- Ir a misa a tiempo. 3- Estar atento/participar en la Misa. 4- Recibir la Sagrada Comunión en estado de gracia. 5- No hables muy alto en la iglesia. 6- Asistir a toda la Misa. 7- Salir siempre de la Iglesia con algo para llevar para vivir la semana.** Una vez más, el corazón de cada religión es la adoración. El corazón de toda adoración es el sacrificio. Así que vayan a Misa y disfrútenla, porque no adoramos una experiencia sino una Realidad: Jesucristo. En la comunión no recibimos algo, sino Alguien, el Pan de Vida, la fuente de salvación. ¡Amén!

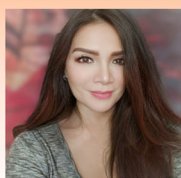

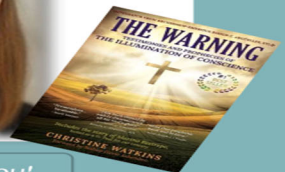

She is also an LCSW who worked for ten years in hospice and nearly ten in post-abortion healing ministry, and we are blessed with a special appearance with her 18-year-old son, Christian.



Christian Watkins - Christian Watkins is a teen evangelist and Catholic speaker with a powerful testimony of God's persistent love. He got caught up in a pursuit of popularity, which led to different sins, including drug use and technology addiction. He speaks of how what our culture is teaching youth is normal and even desired leads sooner or later to disconnection and unhappiness.

WAL Band - For the past 12 years we have been known as the Jacob and Matthew Band, but through prayer and discernment we have decided to rename ourselves WAL. Moving into this new direction, we heavily discussed the question, "How does God see us?" In the end, our answer is quite simple. We hope that WAL's music draws each of your hearts to a knowledge and deep acceptance that we are loved unconditionally and passionately by God.



Joshua Hernandez - Joshua writes spiritual songs about Jesus. Joshua is inspired when in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament. Joshua will lead us during adoration at this conference.



Alvaro Vega - "Communion", born Alvaro Vega, is a Catholic hip-hop artist from South Florida with an international youth evangelization ministry. He began his music career as a secular rapper but soon underwent a life-changing encounter with Jesus Christ which transformed his life and musical direction. A former seminarian, he now dedicates himself to preaching the Gospel to youth through his music and testimony all over the world. His YouTube channel Communion HipHop has over 5 million views and he performed at World Youth Day in Panama in 2019 at the vigil with Pope Francis.

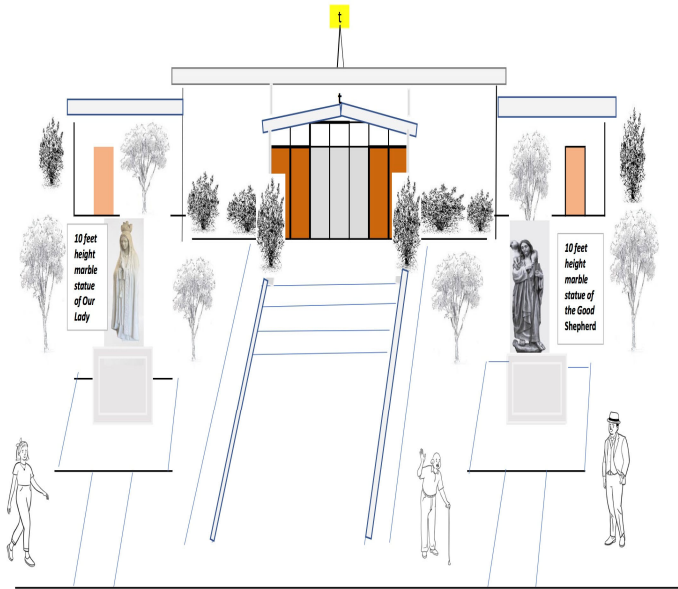
