### GRATITUDE SAVES

Ten lepers begged Jesus, “Have pity on us.” Struck with pity, Jesus heals them without hesitation and questions asked. In times of need, when we return to God and ask for help, what do we usually pray? What do we utter to Him? How humble are we in presenting to God our needs? Our God is always ready to accommodate and dispense necessary intervention for our sakes. When we pray, “Have pity on me, Jesus,” how deep is our faith in Him?

Ten lepers were healed, but the nine refused to return and offer their praise and gratitude. When God heeds our prayers, we may be guilty of not expressing our thanks to Him. We continue with our lives as if nothing happened. We are guilty, but now the Gospel reminds us, what must we do then? Ten lepers were healed, but only one returned, glorified, and thanked Jesus. Jesus commends the Samaritan for his faith which brings him salvation. He acknowledges the blessings received and offers a right and just thanksgiving with all humility. What the Samaritan did is a potent reminder for us all to humbly recognize our gifts from God and to give Him thanks. Imagine Jesus is telling us: “Stand up and go; your faith has saved you!”

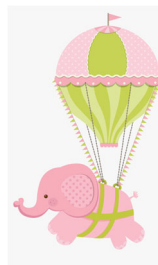

ANNOUNCING THE OPENING OF THE 2023 MASS BOOK!

We will be opening the 2023 Mass Book Thursday, October 20th. In order to insure your health and safety as well as the staff's, we will take mass intention requests again this year via email or in written form beginning Thursday, October 20 at 8:00 am (any received prior will not be valid) and prioritize them in the order we receive them with a maximum of 6 masses for the 1st round (until Nov. 3) then you can request more (6 max. @ a time). No phone calls please so that we can maintain a written, prioritized list as the requests come in. We ask that you make sure your email address and telephone number are included in your request so that we may contact you if there are conflicts with the date requests.

Donation request remains \$10 per mass intention. In accordance with Diocesan policy, only the Saturday morning 8 am mass may be double-booked for intentions. Initially we are limiting the number of requests per family to 6 maximum so that everyone has a fair opportunity.

Mass intentions are available for Monday through Friday masses at 7:30 am, Saturday morning masses at 8 am, our weekend schedule of Saturday at 5:30 pm, Sunday at 8 am, 10 am, 12 noon and 3 pm in Spanish.

We also have mass intentions available on the 1st Friday of the month at 7 pm and the 3rd Friday of each month at 7 pm in Spanish if you'd like to request any of those and any other days of obligation.
