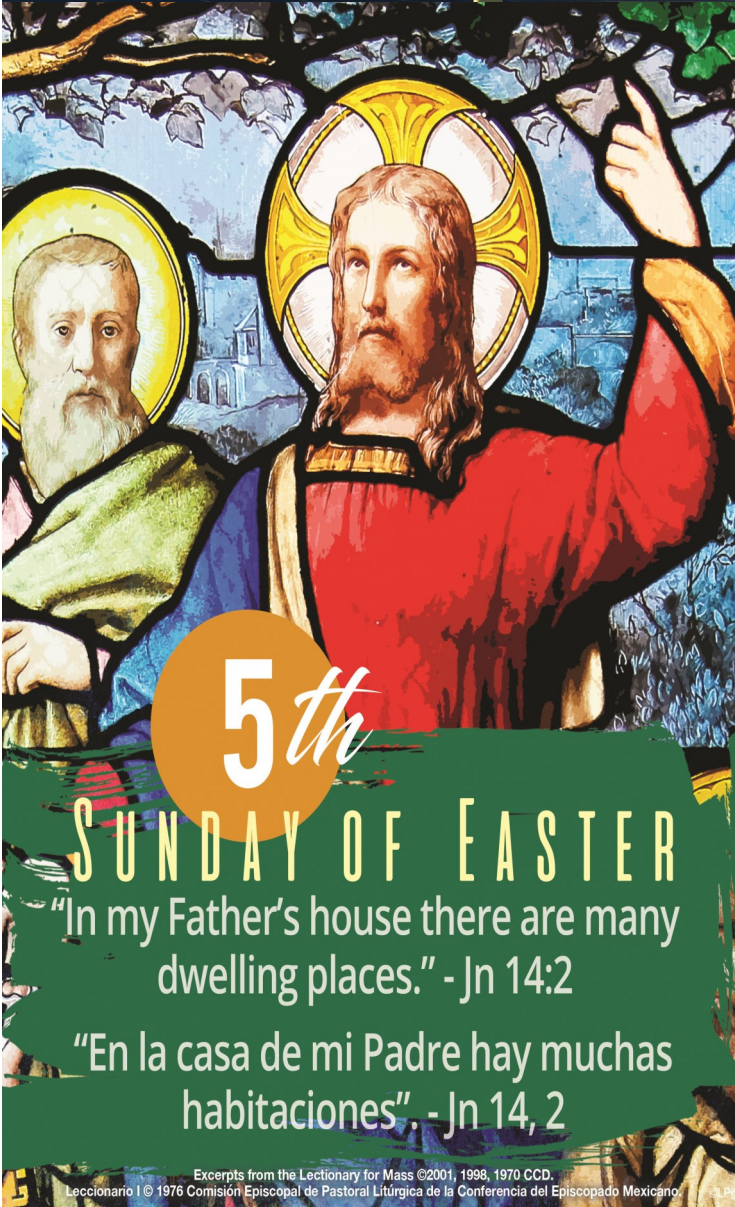

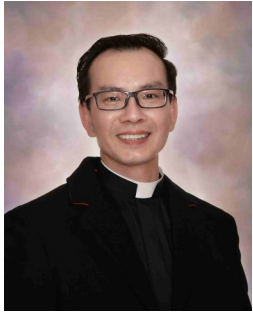

*“Do let your heart be troubled. Have faith in God and have faith in me.”*

Life doesn't always go smoothly for all of us. Sometimes we bring troubles upon ourselves. Other times troubles just come our way. We feel troubled when someone we know and love has died. A friend has been diagnosed with cancer. Our friends have lost their jobs. Others are lonely and depressed, and we feel helpless to help them.

The first reading tells us that there was trouble in the early Christian community as well. The Hellenists complained against the Hebrews because their widows were being neglected. In the Gospel reading, the disciples were troubled when Jesus told them that He was going to leave them. They have left their houses, their families, their friends, their professions to follow Jesus, hoping that he would give them a position in his new kingdom, but there is no sign of the new kingdom; then he was talking about leaving them. Thomas is frustrated, “Master, we do not know where you are going, how we can know the way?” Jesus replied: “Do not let your hearts be troubled. Have faith in God and in me.” By saying this, he calls his disciples and all of us to trust him.

Friends, each day we are given a choice to believe either God is in control of everything, that good things are in store, or we can go around worried and terrified. Fear and faith have some thing in common. They both ask us to believe in something that we don't know for sure. Fear says the pain in your stomach is the same pain your grandmother died from. It is going to happen to you. You better start planning your funeral. The truth is you just ate too much pizza the last night. Here is the key: faith or fear, whatever you meditate on, it is going to take root in you. If you think of fear again and again, you will give it a right to become reality. If you focus on faith, you will become faithful people, no matter what happens.

So my dear friends, when fear knocks, let your faith answer the door. Fear always presents itself much bigger than its reality. It tells you all the worst case scenarios, trying to get you worried and panic. So learn to activate your faith, believing God will bring your stormy days to pass. You will overcome every obstacle, defeat every enemy and become everything God has created you to be. Faith is the passion to the impossible. By saying: *Do not let your hearts be troubled*, Jesus is asking us to trust, to surrender to his providential care. He is asking us to have faith.

May God take away our fear and increase our faith so that in all the storms of life we shall have our eyes and our trust fixed on Jesus who is the way, the truth and the life.

*“Deja que tu corazón se turbe. Ten fe en Dios y ten fe en mí”.*

La vida no siempre va bien para todos nosotros. A veces traemos problemas sobre nosotros mismos. Otras veces, los problemas simplemente se cruzan en nuestro camino. Nos sentimos preocupados cuando alguien a quien conocemos y amamos ha muerto. A un amigo le han diagnosticado cáncer. Nuestros amigos han perdido sus trabajos. Otros están solos y deprimidos, y nos sentimos impotentes para ayudarlos.

La primera lectura nos dice que también hubo problemas en la comunidad Cristiana primitiva. Los Helenistas se quejaron de los Hebreos porque sus viudas estaban siendo desatendidas. En la lectura del Evangelio, los discípulos se turbaron cuando Jesús les dijo que los iba a dejar. Han dejado sus casas, sus familias, sus amigos, sus profesiones para seguir a Jesús, esperando que les dé un puesto en su nuevo reino, pero no hay señales del nuevo reino; luego estaba hablando de dejarlos. Tomás se siente frustrado: “Maestro, no sabemos a dónde vas, ¿cómo podemos saber el camino?” Jesús respondió: “No se turbe tu corazón. Ten fe en Dios y en mí”. Al decir esto, llama a sus discípulos y a todos nosotros a confiar en él.

Amigos, cada día se nos da la opción de creer que Dios tiene el control de todo, que nos esperan cosas buenas, o podemos andar preocupados y aterrorizados. El miedo y la fe tienen algo en común. Ambos nos piden que creamos en algo que no sabemos con certeza. El miedo dice que el dolor en tu estómago es el mismo dolor del que murió tu abuela. Te va a pasar a ti. Será mejor que empieces a planificar tu funeral. La verdad es que comiste demasiada pizza la noche anterior. Aquí está la clave: fe o miedo, sea lo que sea que medites, se va a infundir en ti. Si piensas en el miedo una y otra vez, le darás derecho a convertirse en realidad. Si te enfocas en la fe, te convertirás en una persona fiel, pase lo que pase.

Así que mis queridos amigos, cuando el miedo llame, dejen que su fe le abra la puerta. El miedo siempre se presenta mucho más grande que su realidad. Te cuenta todos los escenarios del peor de los casos, intentando que te preocupes y entres en pánico. Así que aprenda a activar tu fe, creyendo que Dios hará que pasen tus días tormentosos. Superarás todos los obstáculos, vencerás a todos los enemigos y te convertirás en todo lo que Dios te ha creado para ser. La fe es la pasión por lo imposible. Al decir: *No se turbe tu corazón*, Jesús nos pide que confiemos, que nos entreguemos a su cuidado providencial. Él nos está pidiendo que tengamos fe.

*Que Dios nos quite el miedo y aumente nuestra fe para que en todas las tormentas de la vida tengamos los ojos y la confianza fijos en Jesús que es el camino, la verdad y la vida.*
