15th Sunday Year B– Gospel Reflection (Mk 6:7-13)



There are many details in the Gospel we may or may not clearly understand, let's see what Jesus meant by sending out them in pair, by bringing nothing with them, but stick and sandals and by shaking off the dust when being rejected it.

First, Jesus summoned the Twelve and sent them out two by two. Why two? Jesus' time when there was a need of two to witness to a truth. Jesus sent them out by two so that they can be witness for one another against false accusations, and they can care and support each other on the road. But what if these two don't get along? Then they will use their odd situations to become saints. Human relationship is the true test of our faith. It is by the way we relate with one another that people will know that we are Christians. Second, Jesus told them to bring nothing for the journey. No food, no drinks, no money. By saying this Jesus wanted them to rely on God's providence. When Jesus was born, he borrowed a manger to lay his body. He borrowed a boat when he spread the good news; He even borrowed a tomb to lay his dead body for three days. Jesus not only sets the example. He warns us not to find our security in wealth and possessions, because if we bring too many things with us, we will keep our eyes on them, instead on the mission. God will provide for our needs. Third, *"If any place will not welcome you shake off the dust as a testimony against them"* It is instruction for our response to rejection. When we speak the truth, we will be rejected, for people hate the truth. When we are rejected, we must shake it off and move on. Some people fail to do good works because they are afraid of what other people would say. Don't be afraid of what others will say about us. Jesus tells us that rejection is not an excuse to share our times and talents. Shake off the dust from that place, go to a new town and continue the mission. Shaking off the dust from our feet is our own way of letting go and move on. Problems and failures are part of the life of anyone who seeks to make a difference. But sometimes we dwell too long on past failures and allow them to rob our lives of enthusiasm and joy. Sometimes we allow the problems to destroy the peace of our hearts. We forget our primary mission is to sow the seed, to not harvest the success.

May God grant us the grace to know our unique mission and to carry them out effectively despite obstacles on our way, so that at the end of our sojourn here on earth, when we get to heaven, God may say to us, "Well done, good and faithful servant, now enjoy what I have kept as your inheritance," through Christ our Lord. Amen.

15° Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario (Mk 6:7-13)

Hay muchos detalles en el Evangelio que podemos o no entender claramente, veamos qué quiso decir Jesús al enviarlos en parejas, al no traer nada consigo más que bastón y sandalias y sacudir el polvo al ser rechazado. Primero, Jesús llamó a los Doce y los envió de dos en dos. ¿Por qué dos? La época de Jesús cuando se necesitaban dos para dar testimonio de una verdad. Jesús los envió de dos en dos para que puedan ser testigos unos de otros contra las acusaciones falsas, y puedan cuidarse y apoyarse mutuamente en el camino. ¿Pero qué pasa si estos dos no se llevan bien? Luego utilizarán sus extrañas situaciones para convertirse en santos. La relación humana es la verdadera prueba de nuestra fe. Es por la forma en que nos relacionamos unos con otros que la gente sabrá que somos cristianos. Segundo, Jesús les dijo que no trajeran nada para el viaje. Ni comida, ni bebida, ni dinero. Al decir esto, Jesús quería que confiaran en la providencia de Dios. Cuando Jesús nació, pidió prestado un pesebre para recostar su cuerpo. Pidió prestado un barco para difundir la buena nueva; Incluso pidió prestada una tumba para descansar su cadáver durante tres días. Jesús no sólo da el ejemplo. Nos advierte que no busquemos seguridad en las riquezas y las posesiones, porque si traemos demasiadas cosas con nosotros, mantendremos los ojos puestos en ellas y no en la misión. Dios proveerá para nuestras necesidades.

En tercer lugar, "Si en algún lugar no os acogen, sacudid el polvo como testimonio contra ellos". Es una instrucción para nuestra respuesta al rechazo. Cuando decimos la verdad, seremos rechazados, porque la gente odia la verdad. Cuando somos rechazados, debemos deshacernos de ello y seguir adelante. Algunas personas no hacen buenas obras porque tienen miedo de lo que dirán los demás. No tengas miedo de lo que otros dirán de nosotros. Jesús nos dice que el rechazo no es excusa para compartir nuestros tiempos y talentos. Sacude el polvo de ese lugar, ve a un nuevo pueblo y continúa la misión. Sacudir el polvo de nuestros pies es nuestra propia manera de soltarnos y seguir adelante. Los problemas y fracasos son parte de la vida de cualquiera que busque marcar la diferencia. Pero a veces nos detenemos demasiado en los fracasos del pasado y permitimos que nos roben el entusiasmo y la alegría de nuestras vidas. A veces permitimos que los problemas destruyan la paz de nuestros corazones. Olvidamos que nuestra misión principal es sembrar la semilla, no cosechar el éxito. Que Dios nos conceda la gracia de conocer nuestra única misión y de llevarla a cabo eficazmente a pesar de los obstáculos en nuestro camino, para que al final de nuestra estancia aquí en la tierra, cuando lleguemos al cielo, Dios nos diga: "Bien hecho". Siervo bueno y fiel, disfruta ahora de lo que he guardado como herencia tuya", por Cristo nuestro Señor. Amén.



Faith Formation Registration for 2024-2025. Here are the details:
Registration begins June 17th and throughout the summer

A Baptism and Birth Certificate are required with your child's registration form.

Classes Offered:

RCIC (Rite of Christian Initiation for Children; Eng. only): Class for children 7 years and older to receive the Sacrament of Baptism at Easter Vigil. The program starts in September and ends in April. It is held on Sunday mornings.

Starting Date: Sunday, September 15th in Parish Hall from 11:00am-12:00pm (after 10am Mass)

RCIA and Adult Confirmation (Eng. & Span. Classes): Class for adults that are interested in receiving Baptism, First Communion, and/or Confirmation. It is held on Monday evenings.

Starting Date: Monday, September 23rd in Office or Parish Hall from 7:00pm-8:30pm.

First Holy Communion: 2 year program, no matter what grade you start. Classes are on Sundays.

Starting Date: Sunday, September 15th. 9-9:50am (Eng.), 1:10-1:50pm(Eng. & Span.), and 2:00-2:50pm (Span. only).

EDGE: Our middle school program to get ready for confirmation program and receive sacraments if needed. Classes are on Wednesday afternoons.

Starting Date: Wednesday, September 18th in the Parish Hall from 4:30-5:30pm.

Continuing Faith Formation /Post Holy Communion Class: Class to further education after receiving First Communion. It is held on Wednesdays in the afternoon.

Starting Date: Wednesday, September 18th in Parish Hall from 3:00-4:00pm.

Youth Confirmation Program. This is 2 year program. This program is for all high school students who want to receive the sacrament of Confirmation. Classes are on Sundays.

Starting date: Sunday, September 15 in the Parish hall at 11:15am– 12:45pm

Parent Sessions (First Communion and Youth Confirmation Parents): Mandatory Parent Sessions offered once a month in English and Spanish. Classes are held the same time your child/children are in their classes. Parents must attend 5 out of the 7 sessions.
