

*No prophet is honored in his hometown*

Today's gospel reminds us of this expression: "*Familiarity breeds contempt*" Jesus said *no prophet is honored in his hometown* because he was shocked with the way his hometown people treated him. He was surprised with their lack of faith. Truly, when people know each other quite well, when they live together for a long time, they don't feel much of attractions to one another anymore. They start to undermine the talents of each other. It seems like the better we know people, the more likely we are to find their shortcomings and then dislike them. We underestimate their capacity to grow, to change, and to do great things.

Today's Gospel challenges our tendency to label and make quick judgment on others. It invites us to begin to look at one another with more open eyes and more receptive hearts. Jesus came to testify what he has seen and heard, but people rejected him, saying he is crazy. How can he be a Messiah, for obviously he is the son of Joseph? The carpenter! They stereotyped Jesus. Those who approach lives with these fixed concepts and prejudices are people with no faith in God and no trust in others.

The Gospel says Jesus could not do many miracles in his hometown for people lack of faith. "*He could do no deed of power there, except that he laid his hands on a few sick people and cured them.*" (*Mark 6:5*). This is one of the most shocking statements in all the Gospels - that Jesus could not perform miracles. Not that he would not but that he simply could not. Is anything impossible with Jesus? Today's gospel says Yes. It is impossible for Jesus to perform miracles in a situation where there is no faith. Jesus could do all things and wants to do all things for his people. But he needs our faith to release his power. As all-powerful as Jesus is, we have the capacity to disable him by our lack of faith. Faith is like a switch that turns God on, lack of faith turns God off.

Today's gospel is a sad story of people who met Jesus and left without a blessing. As we meet Jesus today in his word and in the Eucharist, let us resolve not to leave without a blessing. Let us renew our faith in him. Amen!

### *Ningún profeta es honrado en su ciudad natal*

El evangelio de hoy nos recuerda esta expresión: "La familiaridad engendra desprecio" Jesús dijo que ningún profeta es honrado en su ciudad natal porque estaba impactado por la forma en que la gente de su ciudad lo trataba. Le sorprendió su falta de fe. En verdad, cuando las personas se conocen bastante bien, cuando viven juntas durante mucho tiempo, ya no se sienten muy atraídas unas por otras. Comienzan a socavar los talentos de cada uno. Parece que cuanto mejor conocemos a las personas, más probabilidades hay de que encontramos sus defectos y luego nos desagraden. Subestimamos su capacidad para crecer, cambiar y hacer grandes cosas.

El evangelio de hoy desafía nuestra tendencia a etiquetar y juzgar rápidamente a los demás. Nos invita a empezar a mirarnos con ojos más abiertos y corazones más receptivos. Jesús vino a testificar lo que había visto y oído, pero la gente lo rechazaba, diciendo que estaba loco. ¿Cómo puede ser un Mesías, si obviamente es hijo de José? ¡El carpintero! Estereotiparon a Jesús. Aquellos que abordan la vida con estos conceptos y prejuicios fijos son personas sin fe en Dios ni confianza en los demás.

El Evangelio dice que Jesús no pudo hacer muchos milagros en su ciudad natal por falta de fe de la gente. "No pudo hacer ningún acto de poder allí, excepto que impuso sus manos sobre unos pocos enfermos y los curó". (*Marcos 6:5*). Esta es una de las declaraciones más impactantes de todos los evangelios: que Jesús no podía realizar milagros. No es que no lo quisiera, sino que simplemente no podía. ¿Hay algo imposible con Jesús? El evangelio de hoy dice sí. Es imposible que Jesús haga milagros en una situación donde no hay fe. Jesús podía hacer todas las cosas y quiere hacerlo todo por su pueblo. Pero él necesita nuestra fe para liberar su poder. Por más todopoderoso que sea Jesús, tenemos la capacidad de incapacitarlo con nuestra falta de fe. La fe es como un interruptor que enciende a Dios, la falta de fe apaga a Dios. El evangelio de hoy es una triste historia de personas que conocieron a Jesús y se fueron sin una bendición. Al encontrarnos hoy con Jesús en su palabra y en la Eucaristía, resolvamos no irnos sin una bendición. Renovemos nuestra fe en él. ¡Amén!


Dearest Parishioners,

**Faith Formation Registration for 2024-2025. Here are the details:  
Registration begins June 17th and throughout the summer**

A Baptism and Birth Certificate are required with your child's registration form.

**Classes Offered:**

**RCIC (Rite of Christian Initiation for Children; Eng. only):** Class for children **7 years and older** to receive the Sacrament of Baptism at Easter Vigil. The program starts in September and ends in April. It is held on Sunday mornings.

**Starting Date: Sunday, September 15th in Parish Hall from 11:00am-12:00pm (after 10am Mass)**

**RCIA and Adult Confirmation (Eng. & Span. Classes):** Class for adults that are interested in receiving Baptism, First Communion, and/or Confirmation. It is held on Monday evenings.

**Starting Date: Monday, September 23rd in Office or Parish Hall from 7:00pm-8:30pm.**

**First Holy Communion:** 2 year program, no matter what grade you start. Classes are on Sundays.

**Starting Date: Sunday, September 15th. 9-9:50am (Eng.), 1:10-1:50pm(Eng. & Span.), and 2:00-2:50pm (Span. only).**

**EDGE:** Our middle school program to get ready for confirmation program and receive sacraments if needed. Classes are on Wednesday afternoons.

**Starting Date: Wednesday, September 18th in the Parish Hall from 4:30-5:30pm.**

**Continuing Faith Formation /Post Holy Communion Class:** Class to further education after receiving First Communion. It is held on Wednesdays in the afternoon.

**Starting Date: Wednesday, September 18th in Parish Hall from 3:00-4:00pm.**

**Youth Confirmation Program.** This is 2 year program. This program is for all high school students who want to receive the sacrament of Confirmation. Classes are on Sundays.

**Starting date: Sunday, September 15 in the Parish hall at 11:15am– 12:45pm**

**Parent Sessions (First Communion and Youth Confirmation Parents):** Mandatory Parent Sessions offered once a month in English and Spanish. Classes are held the same time your child/children are in their classes. Parents must attend 5 out of the 7 sessions.
