Happy Thanksgiving!

My dear friends, we gather together to express our gratitude to God and also acknowledge the loving presence of our family and friends, things they have done for us. *"For all that has been – Thanks. For all that shall be – Yes."* Yes. Some days are easy to be thankful for: wedding days, birthdays, and graduation days? But some days like flat-tires, or computer crash days, tax days? Days when we suffer from loss, pain, failure, brokenness.... Can we be still thankful in such sad days? Yes we can. St. Paul says we must give thanks to God in all circumstances (*1 Thessalonians 5:18*). *Someone said so well, life is something that happens to us while we are busy at something else. We are busy trying to impress everyone; we are busy trying to look good; we are busy trying to succeed; and life passes us by. Life is not in how much we suffer but in how much we miss. How much we take for granted.*

We celebrate this. Feast Day because we are convinced that Thanksgiving is more than turkey, more than football or shopping. Thanksgiving is about – in a word – gratitude. Bishop Fulton Sheen used to say there are two kinds of people in the world. Those who wake up and say, *"Good morning, God!" and those who wake up, saying , "Good God, it's morning."* It's easy to give thanks when things are going our way. But the sign of our maturity in faith is to be thankful even when things are falling apart. Nine out of the ten lepers in today's Gospel were completely captivated in their own misery. They didn't recognize the source of their healing. They weren't able to give thanks because they did not learn that grace comes through the wounds. Gratitude doesn't arise magically if it isn't already present when times are tough. That's why St. Paul tells us to give thanks in all circumstances. Each of us here has something to be grateful for. I am grateful for the gift of faith. Thanks to this faith, i am able to say thanks in all circumstances: not only when i am up, but also when i am down; when my busines is slow, when i am sick, i am in pain, even when i am dying. There are so much be thankful for. May our thanksgiving never cease and may we always praise God from whom all blessings flow! Amen!

Feliz Día de Acción de Gracias

Mis queridos amigos, nos reunimos para expresar nuestra gratitud a Dios y también reconocer la presencia amorosa de nuestra familia y amigos, las cosas que han hecho por nosotros. "Por todo lo que ha sido, gracias. Por todo lo que será, sí". Sí. Algunos días son fáciles de agradecer: ¿días de bodas, cumpleaños y días de graduación? Pero algunos días como los días de pinchazos, o días de fallas de computadora, días de impuestos? Días en los que sufrimos pérdidas, dolor, fracasos, quebrantos... ¿Podemos seguir estando agradecidos en días tan tristes? Sí podemos. San Pablo dice que debemos dar gracias a Dios en todas las circunstancias (*1 Tesalonicenses 5:18*). Alguien dijo muy bien, la vida es algo que nos sucede mientras estamos ocupados en otra cosa. Estamos ocupados tratando de impresionar a todos; estamos ocupados tratando de lucir bien; estamos ocupados tratando de tener éxito; y la vida se nos pasa. La vida no está en cuánto sufrimos, sino en cuánto extrañamos. Cuánto damos por sentado. Celebramos este Día Festivo porque estamos convencidos de que el Día de Acción de Gracias es más que un pavo, más que fútbol o compras. El Día de Acción de Gracias se trata, en una palabra, de gratitud. El obispo Fulton Sheen solía decir que hay dos tipos de personas en el mundo. Los que se despiertan y dicen: "*¡Buenos días, Dios!*" y los que se despiertan diciendo: "*Buen Dios, es de mañana*". Es fácil dar gracias cuando las cosas van como queremos. Pero la señal de nuestra madurez en la fe es estar agradecidos incluso cuando las cosas se están desmoronando. Nueve de los diez leprosos en el Evangelio de hoy estaban completamente cautivados por su propia miseria. No reconocieron la fuente de su curación. No pudieron dar gracias porque no aprendieron que la gracia viene a través de las heridas. La gratitud no surge mágicamente si no está ya presente cuando los tiempos son difíciles. Es por eso que San Pablo nos dice que demos gracias en todas las circunstancias. Cada uno de nosotros aquí tiene algo por lo que estar agradecido. Estoy agradecido por el don de la fe. Gracias a esta fe, puedo dar gracias en todas las circunstancias: no sólo cuando estoy bien, sino también cuando estoy mal; cuando mi negocio va lento, cuando estoy enfermo, cuando tengo dolor, incluso cuando me estoy muriendo. Hay tantas cosas por las que estar agradecido. ¡Que nuestra acción de gracias nunca cese y que siempre alabemos a Dios de quien fluyen todas las bendiciones! ¡Amén!




YOUNG ADULT MINISTRY


