





We are entering the third Sunday of Advent, which is called Gaudete, Rejoicing Sunday. We light the rose candle to remind us to rejoice, for our salvation is near. All the readings of today set up a tone for Joy. 1st reading: Shout for joy, O daughter Zion! Psalm: (6) Cry out with joy and gladness, for among you is the great and Holy One of Israel. In the second reading, St Paul says: Rejoice in the Lord always. I shall say it again: rejoice! When St. Paul tells us to rejoice always, he is not talking about Joy as a passing emotional stages or diferrent moments of feelings such as bad mood, good mood, anger or happy, but a deep abiding

peace. Gaudete, rejoice! be grounded in Christ. It is no longer i who live, but it is Christ who lives in me. That's what St. Paul is talking about. In Christ, the rock, no storm can shake that rock. Take the inventory of your life. What is causing you to be upset? Make a decision to change your approach. Lots of time, it is just a small thing but we make a big deal out of it. Is it really worth losing your joy because you couldn't find a remote control? Your spouse or your BFF forgot your birthday or your football team lost, your flight delayed or cancelled. Learn to relax and be patient.

"This is the day the Lord has made; let us rejoice and be glad in it." God looks at all of us. He sees our weaknesses and failures and sins – and still he says, I know you are not perfect, but I love you anyway and I want you to be my child. God loves us not because we are good but because he is good; not because we are perfect but because he is; not because we are worthy, but because he is gracious. Every day is a gift from God, no matter it's good or bad, because each day is made by Him. He made it for us so we can rejoice! Isn't that wonderful? Friends, the glory of God is human fully alive. In order for your Joy to be complete, to get inner Joy, you are invited to our Advent reconciliation service on Monday, Dec 16 at 7pm. There will be more than 10 priests hearing your confessions. Please come to and be healed so that your joy might be complete. Amen! Happy Advent! Fr. Thi Hoang


Tercer Domingo de Adviento

Estamos entrando en el tercer Domingo de Adviento, que se llama Gaudete, Domingo de Regocijo. Encendemos la vela rosa para recordarnos que debemos regocijarnos, porque nuestra salvación está cerca. Todas las lecturas de hoy establecen un tono para la alegría. 1ª lectura: Grita de alegría, hija de Sión. Salmo: (6) Grita de alegría y júbilo, porque en medio de ustedes está el Grande y Santo de Israel. En la segunda lectura, San Pablo dice: Alegraos en el Señor siempre. Lo diré de nuevo: ¡alegraos! Cuando San Pablo nos dice que nos regocijemos siempre, no está hablando de la alegría como etapas emocionales pasajeras o diferentes momentos de sentimientos como mal humor, buen humor, enojo o felicidad, sino una paz profunda y duradera. Gaudete, ¡regocíjate! Estar arraigado en Cristo. Ya no vivo yo, mas vive Cristo en mí. De eso habla San Pablo. En Cristo, la roca, ninguna tormenta puede sacudir esa roca. Haz un inventario de tu vida. ¿Qué te está causando malestar? Toma la decisión de cambiar tu enfoque. Muchas veces, es solo una cosa pequeña, pero le damos mucha importancia. ¿Realmente vale la pena perder tu alegría porque no pudiste encontrar un control remoto? Tu cónyuge o tu mejor amiga olvidaron tu cumpleaños o tu equipo de fútbol perdió, tu vuelo se retrasó o canceló. Aprende a relajarte y a ser paciente.

"Este es el día que hizo el Señor; regocijémonos y alegrémonos en él". Dios nos mira a todos. Ve nuestras debilidades, fracasos y pecados, y aún así dice: Sé que no eres perfecto, pero te amo de todos modos y quiero que seas mi hijo. Dios nos ama no porque seamos buenos, sino porque Él es bueno; no porque seamos perfectos, sino porque Él lo es; no porque seamos dignos, sino porque Él es misericordioso. Cada día es un regalo de Dios, no importa si es bueno o malo, porque cada día es hecho por Él. ¡Él lo hizo para nosotros para que podamos regocijarnos! ¿No es maravilloso? Amigos, la gloria de Dios es el ser humano plenamente vivo. Para que su alegría sea completa, para obtener alegría interior, están invitados a nuestro servicio de reconciliación de Adviento el lunes 16 de diciembre a las 7 p. m. Habrá más de 10 sacerdotes escuchando sus confesiones. Por favor, vengan y sean sanados para que su alegría sea completa. ¡Amén! ¡Feliz Adviento! Padre Thi Hoang






