

2nd Sunday of Advent

Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Advent is the season of waiting, expecting and longing for Christ's return. There is a right way to wait and there is a wrong way to wait. A wrong way to wait is when things don't happen on our timetable, we get down and discouraged. Even though we know God has good things in store for us, we still lose our patience, we complain and we give up. It is because we are not waiting the right way.

St James 5:7 says: *Be patient as you wait.* A right wait to wait is waiting with expectance. When we wait in a correct way, we are on the lookout. We are making preparations. Just like you are expecting someone for dinner, you don't wait until your guests show up then you decide to start cooking. Most likely you will start early in the day, making sure the house is clean. You will go to the grocery store, buying some flowers for the table, stopping by the bakery to get your favorite dessert (low fat, of course). You make all these preparations because you are expecting someone. Just think of your first date. How much you were longing for it. What if God is your first date? How are you going to prepare to meet him?

In the Gospel of today, St. John the Baptist tells us how these actions to be done to prepare for the coming of our Lord. Valleys are to be filled in, mountains and hills laid low, winding ways straightened and rough roads made smooth. Valleys are sins that create a gap in our relationship with God and with one another such as cheating, lying, gossip, and lack of prayer... Those valleys need to be filled. Mountains and hills refer to our egoistic and selfish tendencies, which do not give place to God. They are sins of pride, arrogance, fighting, anger, lack of forgiveness, hatred. These mountains and hills must be made low. Winding roads and rough ways are sins of double standard living, drunkenness, drug addiction, stealing, cheating and unfaithfulness in marriage. These winding roads and rough ways must be made straight and smooth. Let's prepare the way of the Lord and make straight his paths so we may all see the salvation of God.

2nd Domingo de Adviento

Hermanos y Hermanas en Cristo,

El Adviento es la temporada de espera, anhelo y expectativa por el regreso de Cristo. Hay una manera correcta de esperar y hay una manera incorrecta de esperar. Una manera incorrecta de esperar es cuando las cosas no suceden en nuestro tiempo previsto, nos desanimamos y nos desanimamos. Aunque sabemos que Dios tiene cosas buenas guardadas para nosotros, perdemos la paciencia, nos quejamos y nos damos por vencidos. Esto se debe a que no estamos esperando de la manera correcta.

Santiago 5:7 dice: Ten paciencia mientras esperas. Una espera correcta es esperar con expectativa. Cuando esperamos de la manera correcta, estamos atentos. Estamos haciendo preparativos. Así como estás esperando a alguien para cenar, no esperas hasta que lleguen tus invitados para luego decidir comenzar a cocinar. Lo más probable es que comiences temprano en el día, asegurándote de que la casa esté limpia. Irás a la tienda de comestibles, comprarás algunas flores para la mesa, pasaráis por la panadería para comprar tu postre favorito (bajo en grasa, por supuesto). Haces todos estos preparativos porque estás esperando a alguien. Solo piensa en tu primera cita. Cuánto la anhelabas. ¿Qué pasa si Dios es tu primera cita? ¿Cómo te vas a preparar para encontrarlo?

En el Evangelio de hoy, San Juan Bautista nos dice cómo se deben realizar estas acciones para preparar la venida de nuestro Señor. Los valles deben llenarse, las montañas y las colinas deben allanarse, los caminos sinuosos deben enderezarse y los caminos ásperos deben suavizarse. Los valles son pecados que crean un vacío en nuestra relación con Dios y con los demás, como el engaño, la mentira, el chisme y la falta de oración... Esos valles necesitan ser llenados. Las montañas y las colinas se refieren a nuestras tendencias egoísticas y egoísticas, que no dan lugar a Dios. Son pecados de orgullo, arrogancia, peleas, ira, falta de perdón, odio. Estos montes y colinas deben hacerse bajos. Los caminos tortuosos y los senderos ásperos son pecados de vivir con doble moral, borrachera, adicción a las drogas, robo, engaño e infidelidad en el matrimonio. Estos caminos tortuosos y senderos ásperos deben hacerse rectos y suaves.

Preparamos el camino del Señor y enderezaremos sus senderos para que todos podamos ver la salvación de Dios.




