Synopsis of Good Shepherd Parish History - *Continued*
50 Years of Living and Sharing the Love of Christ

During Holy Week this year, our Youth Ministry performed its 23rd Annual Passion Play, an extraordinary performance with a cast and crew of nearly 100 of our youth. The Good Shepherd Passion Play performance continues to be very popular and has been featured in the media many times over the years. For nearly three decades it has been a labor of love with impressive production values.

With the current leadership of Fr. Carl, the parish operates under the vision-mission: ***Good Shepherd Parish Catholic Parish... One Flock... One Family... Living and Sharing the Love of Christ.***

Through God's grace and blessings, we have more ministries that were added to our parish such as La Pieta Group, the St. Pedro Calungsod Filipino Ministry, the Hispanic/Latino Ministry and the Divine Mercy Prayer Group. We have also fully embraced the work of social justice began through our St. Vincent de Paul Ministry, and have added Brown Bag and Shepherd's Closet and other charity work for the poor and needy in the parish. Father Carl is envisioning and planning to build a "shower for the homeless" with the guidance and support of the parish pastoral council, parish finance council and St. Vincent de Paul. With our passion for the care for the sick, the homebound and the elderly, we have Tuesday Holy Communion to the homebound and the sick and the monthly mass held at Diamond Ridge Rehab Center every 2nd Tuesday of the Month and at Stoneman Village Senior Facility every 4th Thursday of the Month.

Currently, we have more than 500 individuals both children and adults enrolled or registered in our Religious Education Ministry and Program. For our spiritual nourishment and growth, we have our Lenten and Advent Parish Evening of Reflection, the Annual Parish Mission Retreat, Annual Lenten 40 Day Holy Hour, Friday Holy Hour, Month of the Rosary in May and October, regular devotional prayers to our Mother of Perpetual Help, to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, the Chaplet of the Divine Mercy and soon the Devotion to the Holy Infant Child Jesus. We have also a Blessed Sacrament Chapel which is open every day from 7am to 7pm. As we strive to build and gather as a family and community, we have integrated the Parish Monthly Dinners and the Annual Flock Party which is considered as our annual parish festival.

We, as a parish have experienced ups and downs, challenges and victories and sorrows and joy. We hope that together we may receive on our year of jubilee God's immense blessing and the grace to become a vibrant community where each one is formed and transformed to be truly a disciple of Christ sharing and living His Love and Mercy.
