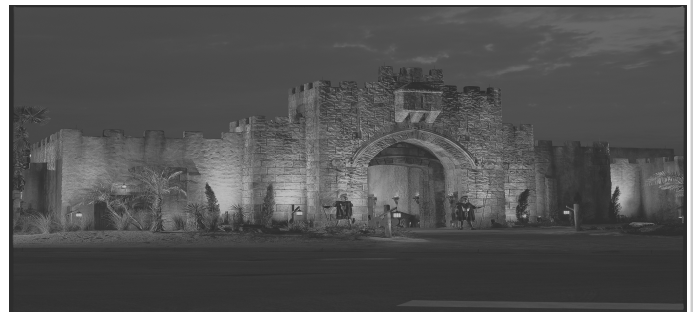

BAPTISM SCHEDULING CHANGES

◆ **Beginning May, 2016 we will be allowing one (1) child to be Baptized during a mass of the family's choosing each weekend.**
