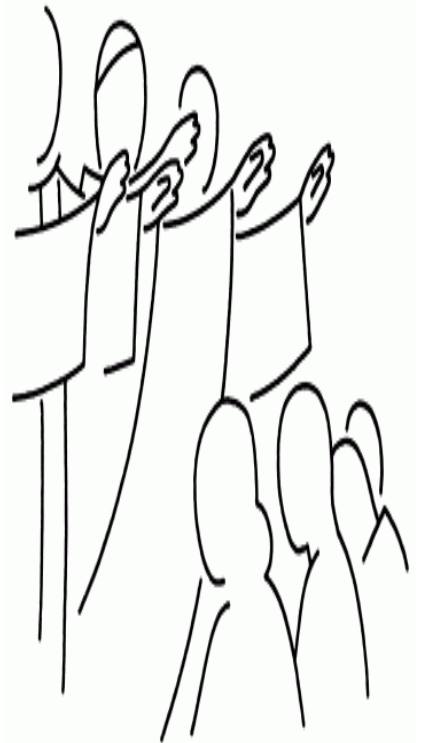

parish priest.

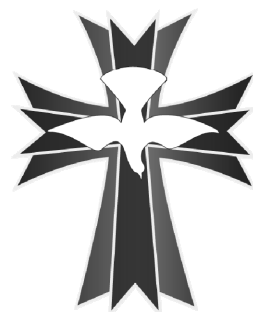

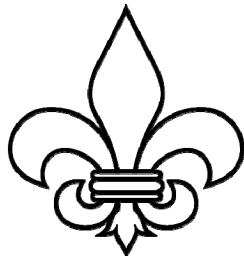
