Originated in Spain, Cursillo (pronounced korseeyo) means "short course" in Christian living. It is an encounter with Christ in a small community of the Church so that His love and grace can be brought to every aspect of life.

The Weekend begins on Thursday evening and ends on Sunday afternoon. During those three days, you'll have an opportunity to:

- · Gain a better understanding of yourself. (Encounter with Self) · Experience the presence and love of Jesus. (Encounter with Christ) · See how personal and spiritual growth can be enhanced through a caring Christian community. (Encounter with Others)
