Dear families and friends of the Good Shepherd community,

Especially, I am very grateful to all those who put together the nice and sweet reception after all the Masses for me. Thank you from the bottom of my heart for your labor of love. May God repay you with his abundant blessings.

My first week here went very well. Thank you for your prayers and support. I have almost settled down. I am truly impressed with everything happening in this parish: from the Liturgy in the church to the administration in the office, everyone of you is giving your extra time and talents in building up this community full of love and joy. I am very grateful for your hard work and sacrifices. As your pastoral administrator, I am happy to continue this legacy. Together we carry on our mission of being one flock, one family, living and sharing the love of Christ.

I would like to share with you this meaningful reflection about the month of August from a Catholic perspective that I found at [Catholic Culture.org/2018](http://CatholicCulture.org/2018): **“Highlights of the Month of August.”**

August is often considered the transitional month in our seasonal calendar. It is the time of the year we begin to wind-down from our summer travels and vacations and prepare for Autumn - back to school, fall festivals, harvest time, etc. The Church in her holy wisdom has provided a cycle of events in its liturgical year which allow the faithful to celebrate the major feasts in the life of Christ and Mary.

Most notably, during August, we celebrate the feast of the Transfiguration (August 6) and the feast of the Assumption (August 15). The month of August is also dedicated to The Immaculate Heart of Mary. The entire month falls within the liturgical season of Ordinary Time, which is represented by the liturgical color green. This symbol of hope is the color of the sprouting seed and arouses in the faithful the hope of reaping the eternal harvest of Heaven, especially the hope of glorious resurrection. It is used in the offices and Masses of Ordinary Time. The last portion of the liturgical year represents the time of our pilgrimage to Heaven during which we hope for reward.

Wednesday, August 15 is the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary. It is the holy day of obligation. We have two English Masses here at the Church of the Good Shepherd: 7:30am and 7:00pm.

August 15 is also the kick off day of faith formation in our parish. All classes will begin that day. Let's lift up our CCD children into the loving arms of our Blessed Mother. May she bring them to Christ so that they may grow in wisdom and holiness. May God, through the intercession of the Blessed Mother, bring the success to the new year of faith formation.
