Message from our
Parochial Administrator



A pig and a chicken walked by a church where a gala charity event was taking place. Getting caught up in the spirit, the pig suggested to the chicken that they each make a contribution. "Great idea!" the chicken cried. "Let's offer them ham and eggs?" "Not so fast," said the pig. "For you, that's a contribution. For me, it's a total commitment."

Friends, one of the most challenging aspects of life is commitment. It is commitment that is at the heart of the 21st Sunday readings. Joshua proclaims that he and his family will serve the Lord. St. Paul speaks of a commitment of the mutual respect and love as the work of husband and wife. And Peter sums it up nicely in the Gospel when he proclaims his commitment of faith, saying: *"Master, to whom shall we go. You have words of eternal life."*

As Christians, we are called to commit ourselves to Christ. Commitment demands a great deal. It demands 100% of ourselves; not 50% or 70%. When God gives us principles to live by, an assignment to accomplish, or a word to guide us, He expects us to commit to them. To commit ourselves is to put other things behind us so that we might be faithful to God and to each other. Commitment isn't always easy. But commitment transforms our lives. It is only commitment that opens us to achieving goals and gaining awards that would never be ours without our willingness to commit ourselves.

Who is Jesus to you? Are you following him? He offers us his flesh and blood, but he also requires our complete commitment to him. He dies for us on the cross, but he also expects us to carry our daily cross with him. He promises us to rise with him, but he also expects us to die with him. He promises us salvation, but he also looks for our conversion. He loves us but he also demands us to love him and others as he has loved us.

So let's commit ourselves to Christ, for as Peter says: *"Master, to whom shall we go. You have the words of eternal life."*

Lecturas de Agosto 2018

Agosto 26, 2018, Libro de Josue, 24, 1-2, 15-17. 18, C. de San Pablo a los Efesios, 5, 21-32, San Juan, 6, 55. 60-69

Queridos Amigos en Cristo,

Tanto la primera como segunda lecturas del Vigésimo Domingo hablaban de sabiduría. San Pablo en su carta a los Efesios llamaba a la gente a vivir no como personas tontas sino como sabias; mientras tanto el autor del Libro de Proverbio decía que los sabios deben comer y beber la comida preparada por el Señor, que es el banquete Eucarístico en el que estamos invitados a participar cada vez que vamos a Misa. Así que las lecturas de ese Domingo nos invitaron a usar nuestra sabiduría para enriquecer la comprensión de la Misa para que podamos participar de todo corazón en ella. Hay cuatro tipos de personas que van a Misa. **En primer lugar**, un turista: los que vienen a tomar algunas fotos, para ver la Iglesia por curiosidad... **Segundo**, un arquitecto: los que vienen a ver cómo se construyó la Iglesia, con qué tipo de material se hizo. **Tercero**, un aficionado al circo: estas personas consideran la Misa como un espectáculo: espectáculo de música, talk show, etc. si la Misa es vista como un espectáculo, habrá buenos espectáculos y espectáculos aburridos. Así que van de compras a Iglesias de alrededor para conseguir "buenos espectáculos" para asistir. Es por eso que algunos han abandonado su FE Católica para unirse a otras denominaciones protestantes, porque encontraron que la Misa era aburrida y no los entretenía en absoluto. **Cuarto**, un verdadero Cristiano: los que van a Misa a comer y beber alimentos preparados por el Señor. Son personas sabias que creen y reconocen la presencia de Jesús en la Eucaristía. Vienen preparados para recibirlo porque El es la única puerta a la vida eterna. Así que somos personas sabias invitadas a participar en el banquete Eucarístico preparado por el Señor. En la Misa, la homilía podría estar en un lenguaje que no entendemos; la música podría estar completamente fuera de sintonía y pista; podría haber niños corriendo por ahí gritando a todo pulmón, lanzando crayones y comiendo meriendas o comiendo crayones y lanzando meriendas, y eso está bien por el momento pero cuando recibimos la Eucaristía es un momento crucial de nuestra semana. Es un momento de gracia y transformación. No importa lo buena que sea la música o la predicación en otro lugar, no podemos dejar la Eucaristía. No dejaremos a Jesús. Ese es el enfoque correcto para la Misa; y sólo cuando vamos a Misa con este celo y pasión, somos capaces de disfrutar de ella de todo corazón. Tengan una semana bendecida y llena de gracia.
