Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

We are entering the third Sunday of Advent, which is called Gaudete or Rejoicing Sunday. The readings of this Sunday set up a tone for Joy. The 1st reading taken from the book of Zephaniah says: *“Shout for joy, O daughter Zion! The Lord has removed the judgment against you. He has turned away your enemies.”* The Psalm says: *“Cry out with joy and gladness, for among you is the great and Holy One of Israel.”* St Paul in the second reading reminds us to *“rejoice in the Lord always for He is near.”*

Every day is worthy of our joy. Every day is a gift, no matter what it goes; it is still a gift from God. Only when we think of this way, we are able to enjoy every moment of it. Each day provides us with opportunities that will never come again. If we wait till we find the perfect job, we will be unemployed. If we delay participation in the spiritual life until things are just right, or until we think we are worthy, then we will miss out on life and faith and God.

“This is the day the Lord has made; let us rejoice and be glad in it” (Ps 118:24). God looks at all of us. He sees our weaknesses and failures and sins – and still he says, *“I know you are not perfect, but I love you anyway and I want you to be my child.”* God loves us not because we are good but because he is good; not because we are perfect but because he is; not because we are worthy, but because he is gracious. Every day is a gift from God, no matter if it’s good or bad, because each day is made by Him. He made it for us so we can rejoice! Isn’t that wonderful?

Friends, *the glory of God is human fully alive.* Take one day a time and live it to its fullness, for yesterday is history; tomorrow is mystery. Today is the gift. That’s why it is called the present. So be happy, for this is the day the Lord has made. Let’s rejoice and be glad in it. In order for your joy to be complete, you are invited to attend our Advent reconciliation service on this Monday, Dec. 17 at 7pm (Bilingual). There will be 7 priests to hear all sizes of sins: small, big, light and heavy. Please come to have a hot shower for your soul, making room for Christ coming to bless you so that your joy might be complete.

The Two Parts of Advent:

Part 1: up until December 16

While most liturgical seasons have the gospel as their main focus, during the first weeks of Advent, the Church gives us daily readings from the prophet Isaiah. With the eyes of faith, these foretell the coming of the Messiah. Rather than a continuous gospel narrative familiar to us for most of the year, this part of Advent offers a wide variety of gospel readings that support the first reading of the day. After almost two weeks of Isaiah readings, we hear the foretelling of a Messiah from other prophets from the Hebrew scriptures - in Sirach, Numbers, Zephaniah and returning to Isaiah. With each passing week, the prophets speak more clearly of the coming of a Savior. So, in reading the first reading, for the first part of Advent, we listen to the anticipation, expectation, hope and promise. In listening to the second reading, we listen for the fulfillment or connection with the gospel.

Las Dos Partes de Adviento:

Parte 1: hasta el 16 de Diciembre,

Mientras que la mayoría de las temporadas Litúrgicas tienen el evangelio como su principal enfoque, durante las primeras semanas de Adviento, la Iglesia nos da lecturas diarias del profeta Isaías. Con los ojos de la fe, estos predicen la venida del Mesías. En lugar de una narrativa continua del evangelio que nos es familiar durante la mayor parte del año, este aspecto de Adviento ofrece una amplia variedad de lecturas del evangelio que apoyan la primera lectura del día. Después de casi dos semanas de lecturas de Isaías, escuchamos la predicción de un Mesías de otros profetas de las escrituras Hebreas en Sirach, Numeros, Zephaniah y volviendo a Isaías. Con cada semana que pasa, los profetas hablan más claramente de la venida de un Salvador. Así que, al leer la primera lectura, para la primera parte de Adviento, escuchamos la anticipación, la expectativa, la esperanza y la promesa. Al escuchar la segunda lectura, escuchamos el cumplimiento o la conexión con el evangelio.

Queridos Hermanos y Hermanas en Cristo,

Estamos entrando en el tercer Domingo de Adviento, que se llama Gaudete o el Domingo de Regocijo. Las lecturas de este Domingo establecen un tono de Gozo. La primera lectura tomada del libro de Zephaniah dice: "*¡Grita con alegría, Oh hija Zion! El Señor ha removido el juicio en tu contra. Ha rechazado a tus enemigos*".

El Salmo dice: "*Clamen con gozo y regocijo, porque entre vosotros está el grande y Santo de Israel*". San Pablo en la segunda lectura nos recuerda "*regocijémonos siempre en el Señor porque Él está cerca*".

Cada día es digno de nuestra alegría. Cada día es un regalo/presente, no importa lo que pase; es todavía un regalo de Dios. Sólo cuando pensamos de esta manera, somos capaces de disfrutar de cada momento. Cada día nos brinda oportunidades que nunca volverán. Si esperamos hasta encontrar el trabajo perfecto, estaremos desempleados. Si retrasamos la participación en la vida espiritual hasta que las cosas sean correctas, o hasta que pensemos que somos dignos, entonces nos perderemos la vida, la fe y Dios.

"*Este es el día que el Señor ha hecho; regocijémonos y alegrémonos en él*" (Sal 118:24). Dios nos mira a todos. Él ve nuestras debilidades fracasos y pecados, y aún así dice: "Sé que no eres perfecto(a), pero te amo de todos modos y quiero que seas mi hijo(a)". Dios no nos ama porque somos buenos, sino porque él es bueno; no porque seamos perfectos, sino porque él lo es; no porque seamos dignos, sino porque él es misericordioso. Cada día es un regalo de Dios, no importa si es bueno o malo, porque cada día es hecho por él. ¡Lo hizo para nosotros para que podamos regocijarnos! ¿No esto maravilloso?

Amigos, *la gloria de Dios es humana y esta plenamente viva*. Tómemonos cada día, un día a la vez y vivámoslo a su plenitud, porque ayer es historia; mañana es misterio. Hoy es un regalo/presente. Es por eso que se llama el presente. Así que seamos felices, porque este es el día que el Señor ha hecho. Regocijémonos y alegrémonos en ello. Para que nuestra alegría sea completa, están invitados a asistir a nuestro **servicio de reconciliación de Adviento este Lunes, 17 de Diciembre a las 7pm (Bilingüe)**. Habrá 7 sacerdotes para escuchar todos los tamaños de pecados: pequeño, grande, ligeros y pesado. Por favor, vengan a tomarse una ducha caliente para su alma, haciendo lugar para Cristo que esta llegando a bendecirlos y así su gozo pueda ser completo.
