

Dear friends in Christ, the Liturgy of second week of Advent takes us into the desert, reflecting upon the message of John the Baptist:

"Prepare the way of the Lord, make straight his paths. Every valley shall be filled and every mountain and hill shall be made low. The winding roads shall be made straight, and the rough ways made smooth, and all flesh shall see the salvation of God."

In the desert there are no cell phones, no water, no games, no entertainment and no distractions. In the desert, we are to ask ourselves these fundamental questions: Who am I? What am I here on earth for? And what must I do to gain the eternal life?

These are the key questions of Advent, which invite us to return to the principals. If you have attended an AA meeting, you would know the first step, out of the 12 step program, is to acknowledge your own weaknesses: not to say you are Ok, but admitting there is something wrong in you. Advent calls us to dig out what prevents us from coming to God. Isaiah singled out the hindrances to be eliminated from our lives. The mountains must be leveled. Our high peaks of selfishness and greed must be gone. Our valleys of neglect of duties can be filled in by acts of faithfulness and love. Our rough ways of wasted time and excess TV, internet chatting, and all the junk-activities can be replaced with a smooth path of a new schedule to allow the Lord to enter into the activities of our lives.

The culture says: *"I am ok, you are ok. Everyone does it."* But our conscience says we are sinners that need repentance. Advent is a great time to confess your sins. It is time to remove the tumors in our lives: Hatred, violence, resentment, inability to forgive, racism... All these stuffs in us must be removed to allow God coming to sanctify and to give us the Joy of Christmas.

So let's repent and open our minds and hearts for the Lord to come in to change us, to renew us. Advent is our reminder that God has not forgotten about us, no matter how we may feel. In fact, he never stops thinking of us, and he is leading us with care to our everlasting happiness.

Live your Advent joyfully!

Esto es también una preparación espiritual para la Navidad y conmemorando el nacimiento de Jesucristo. La celebración es también una manera de pedir la bendición del Señor. La mayoría de la gente cree que si uno completa toda la serie de las 9 misas al amanecer sus deseos serán concedidos. 22. La Palabra tiene en sí una potencialidad que no podemos predecir. El Evangelio habla de una semilla que, una vez sembrada, crece por sí sola también cuando el agricultor duerme (cf. Mc 4,26-29). La Iglesia debe aceptar esa libertad inaferrable de la Palabra, que es eficaz a su manera, y de formas muy diversas que suelen superar nuestras previsiones y romper nuestros esquemas.

Queridos amigos en Cristo, la Liturgia de la segunda semana de Adviento nos lleva al desierto, reflexionando acerca del mensaje de Juan el Bautista: *"Preparen el camino del Señor, hagan recto sus caminos. Cada valle será llenado y cada montaña y cerro se hará bajo. Los caminos sinuosos serán enderezados, y los caminos ásperos serán lisos, y toda carne verá la salvación de Dios.* En el desierto, no hay celulares, ni aguas, ni juegos, ni entretenimientos, ni distracciones. En el desierto, debemos hacernos estas preguntas fundamentales: ¿Quién soy yo? ¿Por qué estoy aquí en la tierra? ¿Y qué debo hacer para ganarme la vida eterna?

Estas son las cuestiones clave del Adviento, que nos invitan a volver a los principios. Si has asistido a una reunión de AA, sabrás el primer paso, del programa de 12 pasos, es reconocer tus propias debilidades: no decir que estás bien, pero admitir que algo erróneo pasa en Ti. Adviento nos llama a desenterrar lo que nos impide venir a Dios. Isaías señaló los obstáculos para ser eliminados de nuestras vidas. Las montañas deben ser niveladas. Nuestros altos picos de egoísmo y codicia deben haber desaparecido. Nuestros valles de negligencia hacia nuestros deberes podemos llenarlos por actos de fidelidad y amor. Nuestras maneras ásperas de desperdiciar el tiempo y del exceso de la TV, el charlar en la redes de la Internet, y todas las actividades-de-chatarra se pueden substituir con un camino liso del nuevo horario para permitir que el Señor entre en las actividades de nuestras vidas.

La cultura dice: estoy bien, estás bien. Todo el mundo lo hace. Pero nuestra conciencia dice que somos pecadores que necesitamos arrepentimiento. Adviento es un buen momento para confesar tus pecados. Es hora de eliminar los tumores en nuestras vidas: el odio, la violencia, el resentimiento, la incapacidad de perdonar, el racismo... Todas estas cosas en nosotros deben ser removidas para permitir que Dios venga a santificar y nos dé gozo de la Navidad.

Así que arrepintamonos y abramos nuestras mentes y corazones para que el Señor venga a cambiarnos, a renovarnos. El Adviento es nuestro recordatorio de que Dios no se ha olvidado de nosotros, no importa cómo nos podamos sentir. De hecho, Él nunca deja de pensar en nosotros, y Él nos está llevando con cuidado a nuestra felicidad eterna.

¡Vive tu Adviento alegre!
