### “The Joy of the Gospel”

The great danger in today’s world, pervaded as it is by consumerism, is the desolation and anguish born of a complacent yet covetous heart, the feverish pursuit of frivolous pleasures, and a blunted conscience. Whenever our interior life becomes caught up in its own interests and concerns, there is no longer room for others, no place for the poor. God’s voice is no longer heard, the quiet joy of his love is no longer felt, and the desire to do good fades. This is a very real danger for believers too. Many fall prey to it, and end up resentful, angry and listless. That is no way to live a dignified and fulfilled life; it is not God’s will for us, nor is it the life in the Spirit which has its source in the heart of the risen Christ.

Aunque tambien existen días de fiesta dedicados a cada miembro de la Sagrada Familia — Jesús, María y José — la fiesta de la Sagrada Familia conmemora su vida juntos y la celebración se centra en la vida religiosa de la familia. Debido al exilio de la sagrada familia a Egipto, un banquete para la sagrada familia ha sido observado por los Coptos desde tiempos tempranos. En el Cristianismo Occidental, sin embargo, la veneración de la Sagrada Familia como grupo, más que como individuos, no surgió hasta el siglo XVII y no fue reconocida oficialmente este dia de fiesta hasta instituida en 1921. Originalmente celebrado el Domingo después de la Epifanía, este dia de fiesta se trasladó al Domingo después de Navidad en 1969 para traerla dentro de la temporada Navideña.
