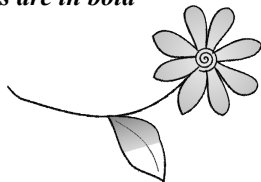

The Host that we receive is not a thing! It’s not a wafer! It’s not bread! It’s a person – He’s alive!"

Mayo Mes de Devociones – Mes de la Madre María

En su encíclica del 1965, Mense Maio, el Papa Pablo VI identificó el mes de Mayo como tiempo oportuno para incorporar oraciones especiales para la paz, en devociones tradicionales de Mayo. [5] no hay estructura firme en cuanto al contenido de una devoción de Mayo. Por lo general incluye el canto de los himnos Marianos, lecturas de las escrituras, y un sermón. Aunque las oraciones probablemente incluyen la recitación del Ave María, el rosario en sí no es generalmente una parte de esta devoción en particular. Los Católicos ofrecen a María en Mayo: peregrinaciones, visitas a iglesias dedicadas a ella, pequeños sacrificios en su honor, periodos de estudio y trabajos bien acabados que se le ofrecen, y una recitación más atenta del rosario.

La última devoción del mes, el 31 de Mayo es a menudo seguida por una procesión solemne, durante la cual una estatua o retrato de la Virgen María se lleva de vuelta a la iglesia. Algunas devociones pueden tener lugar afuera en un bosque o en un lugar especial dedicado a Ella. Esta devoción específica ha sido apoyada por varios papas como el Papa Pío XII en su encíclica Ingruentium Malorum:

La costumbre de la recitación familiar del Santo Rosario es un medio más eficaz. ¡Qué dulce vista-más agradable a Dios-cuando, en Eventide, el hogar Cristiano resuena con la repetición frecuente de alabanzas en honor de la altísima Reina del Cielo! Luego el Rosario, recitado en familia, se reunían ante la imagen de la Virgen, en una admirable Unión de corazones, los padres y sus hijos, que regresaban de su trabajo cotidiano. Los une piadosamente con los ausentes y los muertos. Vincula a todos más estrechamente en un dulce vínculo de amor, con la Santísima Virgen, que, como una madre amorosa, en el círculo de sus hijos, estará allí conferirles una abundancia de los dones de la Concordia y la paz familiar.
