

Mis queridos amigos en Cristo,

Las lecturas del Domingo 26 se destacan con el tema del pecado. En la primera lectura, Josué cometió el pecado de los celos cuando envidiaba el éxito de otros profetas. Santiago en el segundo criticó a la gente rica injusta con sus pecados del lujo y del placer, robando de los pobres, y de asesinatos de los justos. Jesús en el Evangelio se opuso fuertemente al pecado cuando dijo: *"Si tu mano, tu pie o tu ojo te hace pecar, cortarlo o arrancalo, porque es mejor para ti entrar en la vida eterna con todos estos para ser arrojado a Gehenna". (Mk 9:45-48)*. Entonces, ¿qué está diciendo Jesús en este pasaje? ¿está diciendo realmente que tenemos que remover estas partes del cuerpo si nos causan el pecado? Claro que no. Pero, Jesús diría, si tu iphone, ipad, tu computadora, o tu botella de vino/alcohol te hace pecar, tíralo. Jesús muestra su fuerte actitud contra el pecado, porque el pecado es malo. El pecado nos lleva a la muerte, el pecado corta nuestra relación con nuestro Salvador; y el pecado causa la pérdida de nuestra vida eterna. Jesús menciona tres partes de nuestro cuerpo que nos hacen pecar: la mano, el pie y el ojo. En el proceso de pecar, los ojos usualmente toman la primera acción. Por ejemplo, cuando queremos robar un diamante. Los ojos lo miran primero. Ellos mandan los pies para ir. Los pies le dicen a las manos que lo tomen. Sin embargo, la causa de todos los pecados no es la mano, el pie o el ojo, sino el pensamiento maligno que es dirigido por nuestro peligroso enemigo, Satanás cuyo objetivo es engañarnos y robar nuestras almas. ¿pero puede el diablo obligarnos a pecar? No. San Agustín dijo una vez, *"porque como un perro encadenado no puede morder a menos que se acerquen a él, por lo que el diablo no puede dañar con sus tentaciones aquellos que no consienten a ellas. Como el perro que puede ladear a usted, pero no puede morder contra su voluntad.* Para nosotros, nunca debemos consentir a conversar con el diablo. Podemos a veces sentir el calor del aliento de Satanás en la parte posterior de nuestro cuello, pero él no puede tocar un pelo de nuestra cabeza si no le permitimos. Así que si el pecado nos aleja de Dios, entonces el desarraigo del pecado es recurrir a Dios. Cuanto más estamos cerca de Dios, más lejos estamos de las tentaciones de los pecados. Dios luchará por nosotros. Él nos protegerá. Tomemos refugio bajo los brazos amorosos de Dios a través del Sacramento de la reconciliación una vez al mes y recibamos la Eucaristía cada semana para que podamos ser fortalecidos para luchar contra la buena lucha por la salvación de nuestras almas. ¿Cuál eliges, un momento de placer, pero la condenación eterna, o un momento de dolor, pero la vida eterna es tu elección!

La Vida es corta. La Muerte es segura. Pecado la causa. Cristo la cura. ¡Amén!
