Dearest Good Shepherd Family,

The readings of this 23rd Sunday Year B stand out the theme of hearing and listening. In the first reading, Isaiah prophesies the coming with vindication of the God who makes the blind see, the deaf hear, the mute speak and the lame walk. Jesus in the Gospel makes Isaiah's prophesy come true when he heals a deaf and mute man. *"Ephphatha!" — that is, "Be opened!" — And immediately the man's ears were opened, his speech impediment was removed.* (Mark 7:33-34).

The healing story reflects Jesus' intimate, powerful relationship with God and his great compassion toward humanity. He healed with words, touch and physical means. Physical deafness and spiritual deafness are alike; Jesus confronted one type in the man born deaf, the other type in the Pharisees and others who were unreceptive of his message. Jesus was concerned not only with physical infirmity but also spiritual impairment and moral deafness. Our contemporary world has grown deaf to the words of Jesus. It is a spiritual deafness caused by sin. We have become so used to sin that we take it as normal and we have become deafened and blinded to Jesus and his daily call to us.

We are deaf when we do not hear the cry for help raised to us and we prefer to put indifference between our neighbors and ourselves. We are deaf when we turn inward and close ourselves to the world because of selfishness, pride, resentment, anger, jealousy and our inability to forgive others. We are deaf when we refuse to recognize those who suffer in the world around us, and do not acknowledge situations of inequality, injustice, poverty and the devastation of war. We are deaf when we refuse to hear the cry of the unborn, of those whose lives are in danger because they are elderly, handicapped, and chronically ill, while others wish to end their lives out of misguided mercy.

Ephphatha- Be opened! These words of Jesus remind us to listen to his teachings and open our hearts for the need of others. Let's be doers of the Word as we go out and say, "God has done all things well. He makes me hear and speak!" Praise the Lord!

Un mensaje de nuestro Administrador Parroquial

Mi querida Familia de el Buen Pastor

Habrán oido hablar del reciente escándalo de abuso de Pensilvania. Como sacerdote, me siento profundamente avergonzado. Y quiero decir vergüenza a aquellos que abusaron y se aprovecharon de nuestros niños inocentes. Han deshonrado a Cristo y a su Iglesia. Quisiera compartir con ustedes la carta de nuestro Obispo en respuesta a este asunto.

Queridos Hermanos y Hermanas en Cristo,

"Las noticias que hemos estado recibiendo acerca de las horribles acciones de sacerdotes, obispos y cardenales me han aturrido y disgustado. Los que han perjudicado a los niños y a los adultos vulnerables deben ser responsables. Los obispos que se negaron a detener este comportamiento inmoral y criminal también deben ser responsables. Estoy avergonzado por las acciones de estos hombres y he prometido trabajar con todas las personas de buena voluntad para hacer de nuestra Diócesis un lugar seguro para todos.

"Con ese fin, tenemos pautas y procedimientos a seguir que cada persona que sirve en nuestra Diócesis, ya sea clérigos, religiosos, personal o laicos voluntarios, recibe entrenamiento en cómo identificar y detener el comportamiento depredador. La Diócesis de Oakland tiene una pauta de tolerancia cero al abuso sexual de menores por parte de cualquiera que sirva a la Iglesia. También contamos con personal que responde a cada alegato de abuso, y tiene un equipo comprensivo y receptivo para ayudar a sobrevivientes de abuso sexual clerical.

Tenemos una Junta de Revisión Diocesana Independiente compuesta por expertos laicos en psicología, investigadores de la policía, jueces jubilados y sobrevivientes de abuso, que examina las quejas de mal comportamiento. Yo sigo sus recomendaciones.

"Yo acojo con beneplácito la iniciativa del Cardenal DiNardo, Presidente de la Conferencia Episcopal de Estados Unidos, cuya declaración del 16 de Agosto está en <http://www.usccb.org/News/2018/18-139.cfm> para establecer una investigación sobre las cuestiones que rodean la rendición de cuentas de los obispos, una apertura de nuevos y confidenciales canales de información para las quejas, la independencia adecuada y laicos, no clerical, el liderazgo del proceso.

"El amor de Cristo nos obliga a ser mejores modelos de su amor, misericordia y sanación en Jesús. Nunca debemos violar la confianza depositada en nosotros. Como Obispo de Oakland, prometo que habrá consecuencias para los que lo hacen."
