## Holy Week is a Week of Love

Where is love in the midst of pain and suffering? It seems that love is not present but only more painful if you are being persecuted and condemned by your own people, especially by those you loved and helped. It's very frustrating to know some ironies in life, people that you think will understand you will come out to be the very people who are set to condemn you. When it happens, the pain within you is doubled, it penetrates deeply into the heart. The people of Jerusalem made a happy welcoming for Jesus in the beginning of the gospel today but unfortunately at the end, they will be the same people to condemn him.

Today we begin the Holy Week. Our attention is focused on the sacrificial death of Jesus. In our gospel today, he felt the worse pain and suffering a man could experience: from the time he knew that he was going to be betrayed and commanded the betrayer to hurry his evil plot; in the breaking of the bread that he would eventually be broken, in the garden of Getsemane where he struggled so much, when he was denied by his apostle; scourged and condemned to death; crowned with thorns and rejected by the people who chose Barrabas instead of him; carried his cross; condemned, judged, spitted on while going to his death on Calvary; nailed on the cross; felt abandoned and forsaken by His Father...Like us, he also thought of escaping from pain and suffering... "Father, if it is possible, let this cup pass me by...not my will but yours be done"...However, he chose to obey. He chose to be merciful... "forgive them, for they know not what they do." He chose to love us unconditionally. This is how pain and suffering should be faced...with humble obedience to the will of the Father and with unconditional love. This is the way that we are healed from our pains. This is the way that we become holy, we become like Jesus.

If we truly accept and offer all of our pain and suffering to Jesus, we put ourselves into the healing process. Gradually the pain will die down, more so if we also share this healing with our brothers and sisters who are also in pain. Our lives would have no sense and meaning if we do not accept and offer all our pains and sacrifices and even sufferings to Jesus. Jesus is looking at us with love and mercy even in the midst of his pain and suffering. Let us gaze on his loving and merciful look so that we may be healed of our own pains. Jesus' great love continues to be expressed today. As long as there are people who know how to be merciful, to be forgiving, to be patient, to understand, to sacrifice and to love. As long as there are people who follow Jesus as their Lord and Savior and how Jesus loves, Jesus will surely remain in us and with us, giving us faith, hope and love as we live here on earth.

We begin this Holy Week with love in our hearts for Holy Week is also a week of love, a love unconditionally given by God to us. Let us offer our pains and sacrifices to Jesus out of our love for Him. Let us then love like Jesus loves, today and always.



## Semana Santa es una Semana de Amor

¿Dónde está el amor en medio del dolor y el sufrimiento? Parece que el amor no está presente, sino que es más doloroso si estás siendo perseguido y condenado por tu propio pueblo, especialmente por aquellos a quienes amastes y ayudaste. Es muy frustrante conocer algunas ironías en la vida, gente que crees que entenderá será la misma gente que te condenará. Cuando sucede, el dolor dentro de Ti se duplica, penetra profundamente en el corazón. En el comienzo del Evangelio de hoy, el pueblo de Jerusalén recibió a Jesús con una agradable bienvenida, pero desafortunadamente al final, serán las mismas personas que lo condenarán.

Hoy comenzamos la Semana Santa. Nuestra atención se centra en la muerte sacrificial de Jesús. En nuestro Evangelio de hoy, El sintió el peor dolor y sufrimiento que un hombre podía experimentar: desde el momento en que supo que iba a ser traicionado ordenó al traidor que apresurara su malvada conspiración; en la partida del pan que eventualmente sería quebrantado, en el jardín de Getsemaní, donde luchó tanto, cuando fue negado por su Apóstol; azotado y condenado a muerte; coronado con espinas y rechazado por el pueblo que eligió a Barrabas en lugar de Él; llevó su cruz; condenado, juzgado, escupido mientras iba a su muerte en el Calvario; clavado en la Cruz; se sentía abandonado y abandonado por su Padre... Como nosotros, Él también pensó en escapar del dolor y el sufrimiento... "Padre, si es posible, deja que esta Copa me pase... pero que no sea mi voluntad, sino la tuya" ... Sin embargo, eligió obedecer. Él eligió ser misericordiosos... "perdónalos, porque no saben lo que hacen." Eligió amarnos incondicionalmente. Esto es como el dolor y el sufrimiento deben ser enfrentados... con humilde obediencia a la voluntad del Padre y con amor incondicional. Esta es la forma en que somos curados de nuestros dolores. Esta es la manera en que llegamos a ser santos, llegamos a ser como Jesús.

Si realmente aceptamos y ofrecemos todos nuestros dolores y sufrimientos a Jesús, nos ponemos a nosotros mismos en el proceso de curación. Gradualmente el dolor se morirá, más si también compartimos esta sanación con nuestros hermanos y hermanas que también están sufriendo. Nuestras vidas no tendrían sentido y significado si no aceptamos y ofrecemos todos nuestros dolores, sacrificios e incluso sufrimientos a Jesús. Jesús nos está mirando con amor y misericordia incluso en medio de su dolor y sufrimiento. Contemplemos su mirada amorosa y misericordiosa para que podamos ser sanados de nuestros propios dolores. El gran amor de Jesús se sigue manifestando hoy. Mientras haya personas que sepan ser misericordiosos, que sepan perdonar, ser pacientes, entender, sacrificar y amar... Mientras hayan personas que sigan a Jesús como su Señor y Salvador y cómo Jesús ama, Jesús seguramente permanecerá en nosotros y con nosotros, dándonos fe, esperanza y amor al vivir aquí en la tierra.

Comenzamos esta Semana Santa con amor en nuestros corazones porque la Semana Santa es también una semana de amor, un amor incondicionalmente dado por Dios a nosotros. Ofrezcamos nuestros dolores y sacrificios a Jesús por nuestro amor por Él. Amemos entonces como Jesús ama, hoy y siempre.
