A Reflection by Deacon Gustavo

Second Sunday of Easter / Divine Mercy

Happy Second Sunday of Easter. Today the Gospel tells us that the disciples were possibly in the same place where they were with Jesus at the Last Supper; They were still frightened and were still afraid that the Jews would kill them too.

Jesus appears to them and the first thing that He tells them was **"Peace be with you."**

"As the Father has sent me, so I send you." Here we have the **Co-Mission** that we must not forget. It is the moment when Jesus sends them to share all that He had taught them with the rest of the world. Jesus needed the disciples to carry the Father's Kingdom, He needs all of us to help Him in His Mission. And at the same time, the disciples and we need Jesus in order to understand His Message. In other words, Jesus needs us to carry His Message and we need Him to understand what that message is. The Disciples and we cannot bring our own message, but the Message of Christ.

The Gospel speaks to us that Thomas did not believe when the other disciples told him that Jesus had been with them, it was not that Thomas did not love Jesus, he was a person who had to convince himself first. After Thomas fully accepted Jesus, he said one of the most complete testimonies of the New Testament: **"My Lord and My God"**; Thomas, recognized Jesus as his God and Lord. In the same way we must accept Jesus as our Lord.

At the same time, today we celebrate the Feast of Divine Mercy. **God's Mercy** has always been present throughout history. During the 1930s, St. Faustina reminded us of **His Mercy** which we had forgotten and the phrase she said to put on the image of Jesus: **"Jesus I Trust in You"**.

If we see Thomas's testimony in today's Gospel it was **"My Lord and My God"**. The two sentences make a complete testimony of total trust and acknowledgement of Jesus as God and Lord.

Sisters and brothers, I invite you today **to say Yes to Jesus**, recognizing Him as our Lord and Savior, and accepting His invitation to go and share His Message, His Mission to the whole world.

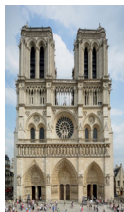

Segundo Domingo de Pascua / Fiesta de la Divina Misericordia

Feliz Segundo Domingo de Pascua. Hoy el Evangelio nos cuenta que los discípulos estaban posiblemente en el mismo lugar donde estuvieron con Jesús en la última Cena; seguían asustados y seguían teniendo miedo de que los judíos los mataran a ellos también.

Jesús, se les aparece y lo primero que les dice **“La Paz esté con ustedes, como el Padre me envió a mí, así yo los envió a ustedes”**. Aquí tenemos la **Co-Misión** que no debemos olvidar. Es el momento donde Jesús los envía a compartir todo lo que les había enseñado con el resto del mundo. Jesús necesitaba de los discípulos para llevar el Reino del Padre, nos necesita a todos nosotros para ayudarlo en su Misión.

Y al mismo tiempo, los discípulos y nosotros necesitamos de Jesús para entender su Mensaje. En otras palabras, Jesús nos necesita para llevar su Mensaje y nosotros lo necesitamos a ÉL para entender cuál es ese mensaje. Los discípulos y nosotros no podemos llevar nuestro propio Mensaje, sino el Mensaje de Cristo.

El evangelio nos habla que Tomás no creyó cuando sus compañeros le dijeron que Jesús había estado con ellos, no era que Tomás no amara a Jesús, él era una persona que tenía que convencerse primero así mismo. Después que Tomás aceptó por completo a Jesús, dijo una de las confesiones más completas del Nuevo Testamento: **Señor mío y Dios mío**; Tomás, reconoció a Jesús como Dios y Señor. De la misma manera nosotros debemos aceptar a Jesús como nuestro Señor.

Al mismo tiempo hoy celebramos la Fiesta de la Divina Misericordia. **La Misericordia de Dios** siempre ha estado presente a través de la historia. Por los años de 1930s, Santa Faustina nos recordó esa parte de Dios que habíamos olvidado, **su Misericordia**, y la frase que ella dijo que pusieran en la imagen de Jesús fue: **“Jesús en Ti Confío”**.

Si vemos la confesión de Tomás en el evangelio de hoy fue: **“Señor mío y Dios mío”**. Las dos frases hacen una confesión, una declaración completa de confianza total y reconocimiento de Jesús como Dios y Señor.

Hermanas (os), les invito que hoy le **digamos Sí a Jesús**, reconociéndolo como nuestro Señor y Salvador, y aceptando su invitación de ir a compartir su Mensaje, su Misión a todo el mundo. **“Señor mío y Dios mío” - “Jesús en ti Confío”**
