

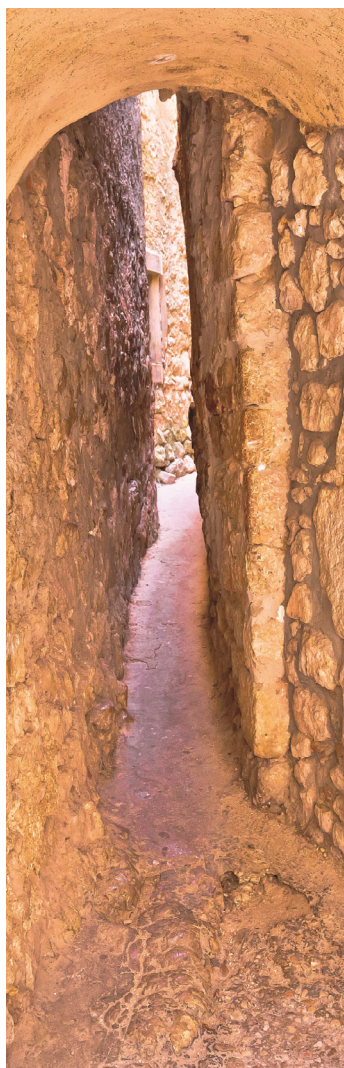

XXI Sunday Ordinary Time

Jesus continues his journey to Jerusalem, passing through towns and villages in which he taught. Someone asks Jesus: Lord, are there few who will be saved? The question as it looks, points to the number: How many are going to be saved, a few or many? Jesus' response shifts attention from "how many" to "how" we are saved.

It is the same attitude we notice about the Parousia: the disciples asked "when" will the return of the Son of man occur and Jesus responds by indicating "how" to prepare for that return, what to do during the wait (Mt 24:3-4). The purpose of Jesus is to educate us and move us from plain curiosity to wisdom, from the idle questions to those that passionate people ask, to the real problems that concern the Kingdom. Then in this gospel Jesus seizes the opportunity to instruct us on the requirements of salvation.

Jesus declared that the entry into the Kingdom is not automatic, but the result of walking through life. Jesus tells us: "You make every effort to enter."

We take a risk. It is easy to believe that, once we have given ourselves to Jesus, we are already within the Kingdom and we can sit quietly as if we have reached the goal. There is no such thing in the Christian life. If we're not moving forward all the time, we're moving backwards. Christian life is like when we climb a very high mountain; along the way we come across a lot of stumbles, but we always look toward the top and that helps us to move forward with the project of reaching the top; it's a constant to go forward and up.

"Once a person who had many goods and a very large and luxurious house on earth reached Heaven. This person was received by an angel to lead her home. They passed in front of many palaces and the person expected one of those to be theirs. They left the main street of Heaven and toured the outskirts, where the houses were much more modest; and finally, they came to one that was nothing more than a shack. This is your house; the angel told the person. What? The person protested; this can't be my house. I'm sorry, said the angel, but that's all we could build you with the materials you sent us from the earth."

Life in Heaven is not like on earth. The first on earth will be the last in Heaven; and the last on earth, will be the first in Heaven. The important thing is not to know "how many" are going to be saved, but "how" we're going to save ourselves.

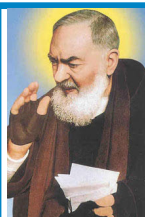

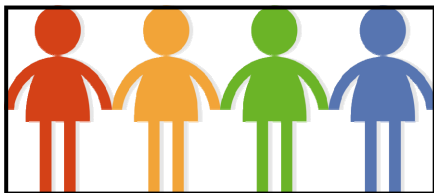

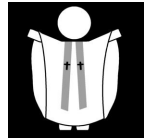

XXI Domingo Tiempo Ordinario

Jesús continua su viaje a Jerusalén, pasando por pueblos y aldeas en los que enseñaba. Alguien pregunta a Jesús: Señor, ¿son pocos aquellos que se salvarán? La pregunta como se ve, apunta al número: ¿Cuántos vamos a salvarnos, pocos o muchos? La respuesta de Jesús traslada la atención del "cuántos" al "cómo" nos salvamos.

Es la misma actitud que notamos a propósito de la parusía: los discípulos preguntan "cuándo" se producirá el retorno del Hijo del hombre y Jesús responde indicando "cómo" prepararse para ese retorno, qué hacer durante la espera (Mt 24,3-4). El propósito de Jesús es educarnos y pasar del plano de la curiosidad al de la sabiduría, de las preguntas ociosas que apasionan a la gente, a los verdaderos problemas que atañen al Reino. Entonces, en este evangelio Jesús aprovecha la oportunidad para instruirnos sobre los requisitos de la salvación. Jesús declaró que la entrada en el Reino no es automática, sino el resultado del caminar por la vida. Jesús nos dice: "vosotros haced el máximo esfuerzo para entrar"

Corremos un riesgo. Es fácil creer que, una vez que nos hemos entregado a Jesús, ya estamos dentro del Reino y nos podemos sentar tranquilamente como si hubiéramos llegado a la meta. No hay tal en la vida cristiana. Si uno no está avanzando continuamente es que está, retrocediendo. La vida cristiana es como cuando escalamos una montaña muy alta; en el trayecto nos encontramos con muchos tropezos, pero siempre miramos hacia la cima y eso nos ayuda a seguir adelante con el proyecto de llegar a la cima; es un constante ir hacia delante y hacia arriba.

"Una vez una persona que tenía muchos bienes y una casa muy grande y lujosa en la tierra, llegó al Cielo. A esa persona la recibió un ángel para guiarla a su casa. Pasaron por delante de muchos palacios y la persona esperaba que cualquiera de esos fuera el suyo. Salieron de la calle principal del Cielo y recorrieron las afueras, donde las casas eran mucho más modestas; y por último llegaron a una que no era más que una chabola. Esta es tu casa le dijo el ángel. ¿qué? Protestó la persona; esto no puede ser mi casa. Lo siento, dijo el ángel, pero eso es todo lo que pudimos construirle con los materiales que nos envió desde la tierra".

La vida en el Cielo no es como en la tierra. Los primeros en la tierra resultarán los últimos en el Cielo; y los últimos en la tierra, serán los primeros en el Cielo. Lo importante no es saber "cuántos" vamos a salvarnos, sino "cómo" vamos a llegar a salvarnos.
