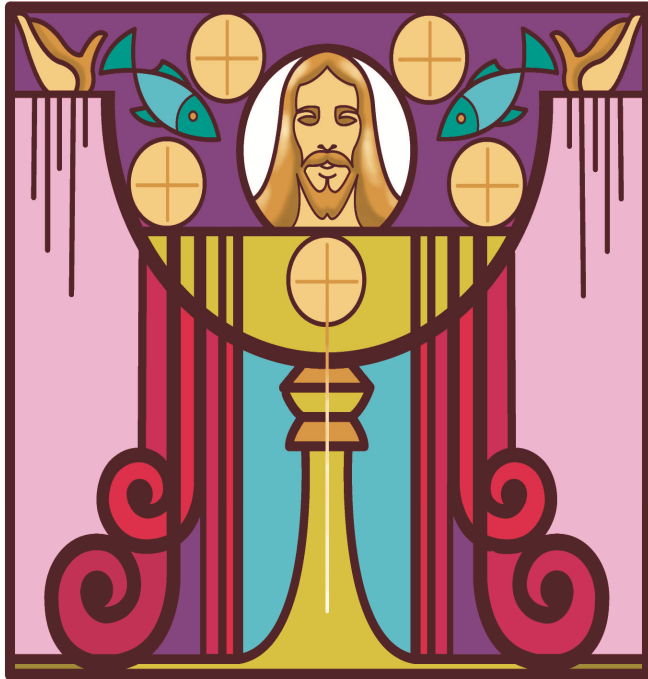

**Doctrinal Message:** Today's liturgy makes us realize something important: "Man, every man, needs an integral diet."

*The bread of the word.* Jesus, before multiplying the loaves to feed the multitude, he spoke to them of the Kingdom of God, that is, he provided them with the bread of his word, for blessed are they who hunger for the word, for they shall be satiated. Also, in the first reading to the offering of the bread and wine, made to Abraham by Melchizedek, follows a blessing, which is like the spiritual bread that God bestows on Abraham through the king-Priest of Salem.

*The bread of the signs.* The Miracles of Jesus, besides being extraordinary facts beyond the natural laws, are signs of the Kingdom of heaven, because they refer us to that new world governed and guided by the power of God. Therefore, Jesus, after having distributed the bread of the word to the multitude, gives them the bread of the signs.

*The bread of the Eucharist.* The Christian diet would be incomplete if the bread of the Eucharist is missing, that bread that is the body of Christ. In the Blessed Sacrament of the Eucharist are true, real and substantially, the body and the blood together with the soul and the divinity of our Lord Jesus Christ, and therefore the whole Christ.

#### **Pastoral Suggestions**

*Hunger for bread, hunger for God.* It is something painful, that makes us think, the fact that after 2000 years of Christianity, there are millions of brothers who are hungry for bread, and this is not thousands of miles from our house, but in our neighborhood, in our city, in our country. Didn't Jesus multiply the breads to quench the hunger? He did not say to his disciples, do you feed them? Have we not spiritualized our faith too much? Have we not reduced our faith to the strictly private sphere? It is certainly not possible to identify Christianity with the UN of charity and solidarity, but in the very heart of Christianity is love for others, especially the needy. We Christians must organize ourselves at a parochial, diocesan, national, and international level to banish the hunger of the Earth. If there is a child who starves, our Christian conscience cannot be calm. The hunger for bread is terrible, but what about the hunger for God?

*A free bread for everyone.* The Eucharist is that. God, our Father, gives us free food from the body of Christ, whenever we want to receive it with the proper provisions. If this food does not cost, how is it possible that there are so few who receive it? Don't they appreciate it? It is also the one and only bread for all: The Eucharist is the sacrament of absolute Christian equality. There is No Eucharist for the rich and the other diverse for the poor. For Christ, bread of our soul, we are all equal. In the face of Christ, the Eucharist, all economic or social barriers disappear.

*Reflection of Pope Francis for the feast of Corpus Christi*

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

This weekend we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Eucharist. This feast day reminds of us the Mass that we attend everyday or every week. In this regard, I would like to remind all of you to respect the sacredness of the Mass by following the these instructions:

1- **Mass Attendance:** Go to Mass on time. Actively participate in the Mass by singing and praising God. Attend the whole Mass (leaving the church after our final song).

2- **Attire:** As the weather warms up, please remember to dress modestly. Shoulders and knees covered, with modest necklines, are an outward sign of our inner intention of respect.

3- As you leave church, kindly straighten **the hymnals and missalettes**, pick up any **trash**, and leave **the kneeler** up. Those celebrating at the next Mass will appreciate a tidy environment.

4- Behave reverently in the Church all the time, and regularly go to confession in order to worthily receive **Holy Communion**. Abstain for at least one hour before Holy Communion from any food and drink, except for only water and medicine.

5- The **bulletin** provides great reading and reflection materials – but please don't read them during Mass. Keep your attention on the Lord.

6- Please remember to turn off all **cell phones and electronic devices** before entering the church.

7- **Our Children:** Children are welcome at Mass, and parents should be commended for making Sunday Mass a priority in their lives. If your child is attending Mass with you and begins to cry or be disruptive to those trying to pray around you, we ask that you take your child into our cry room (the vestibule) in the back of church until comforted enough to rejoin our assembly in prayer.

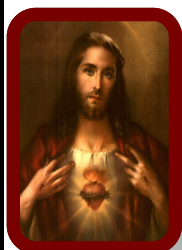

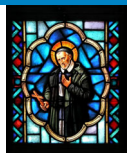

## Mensaje doctrinal

La liturgia de hoy nos hace caer en la cuenta de algo importante: "El hombre, todo hombre, tiene necesidad de una dieta integral".

*El pan de la Palabra.* Jesús, antes de multiplicar los panes para alimentar a la multitud, "les hablaba del Reino de Dios", es decir, les proporcionó el pan de su Palabra, porque bienaventurados los que tienen hambre de la Palabra, pues serán saciados. También en la primera lectura a la ofrenda del pan y el vino, hecha a Abrahán por parte de Melquisedec, sigue una bendición, que es como el pan espiritual que Dios otorga a Abrahán por medio del rey-sacerdote de Salem.

*El pan de los signos.* Los milagros de Jesús, además de ser hechos extraordinarios más allá de las leyes naturales, son signos del Reino de los cielos, porque nos remiten a ese mundo nuevo regido y guiado por el poder de Dios. Por eso, Jesús, después de haber repartido a la multitud el pan de la Palabra, les regala con el pan de los signos.

*El pan de la Eucaristía.* La dieta cristiana quedaría incompleta si faltara el pan de la Eucaristía, ese pan que es el cuerpo de Cristo. En el santísimo sacramento de la Eucaristía están contenidos verdadera, real y substancialmente el Cuerpo y la Sangre junto con el alma y la divinidad de nuestro Señor Jesucristo, y, por consiguiente, Cristo entero.

## Sugerencias pastorales

*Hambre de pan, hambre de Dios.* Es algo doloroso, que nos pone a pensar, el hecho de que después de 2000 años de cristianismo, haya millones de hermanos que tienen hambre de pan, y esto no a miles de kilómetros de nuestra casa, sino en nuestro barrio, en nuestra ciudad, en nuestro país. ¿No multiplicó Jesús los panes para saciar el hambre? No dijo a sus discípulos: ¿dadles vosotros de comer? ¿No hemos espiritualizado demasiado nuestra fe? ¿No hemos reducido nuestra fe al ámbito estrictamente privado? Ciertamente no se puede identificar el cristianismo con la ONU de la caridad y de la solidaridad, pero en la entraña misma del cristianismo está el amor al prójimo, sobre todo al más necesitado. Los cristianos hemos de organizarnos, a nivel parroquial, diocesano, nacional, internacional para desterrar el hambre de la tierra. Mientras haya un niño que muera de hambre, nuestra conciencia cristiana no puede estar tranquila. El hambre de pan es terrible, ¿pero y el hambre de Dios?

*Un pan gratis y para todos.* La Eucaristía es eso. Dios, nuestro Padre, nos da gratuitamente el alimento del Cuerpo de Cristo, siempre que lo queramos recibir con las debidas disposiciones. Si este alimento no cuesta, ¿cómo es posible que sean tan pocos los que lo reciben? ¿No será que no lo valoran? Es además un mismo y único pan para todos: la eucaristía es el sacramento de la absoluta igualdad cristiana. No existe una eucaristía para ricos y otra diversa para pobres. Para Cristo, pan de nuestra alma, todos somos iguales. Ante Cristo Eucaristía desaparecen todas las barreras económicas o sociales.
