

There is a song that says: "Spirit of God in the clear running water, blowing to greatness the trees on the hill. Spirit of God in the finger of morning, fill the earth, bring it to birth and blow where You will. Blow, blow, blow till I be...but breath of the Spirit blowing in me."

We celebrate today the Pentecost Sunday, the Sunday dedicated to the Third Person of the Holy Trinity, God the Holy Spirit and in tradition, the Birthday of our Church.

In the Gospel today, Jesus breathed on the disciples and said, "Receive the Holy Spirit!" The Holy Spirit is like the gentle breath coming from God that gives life. It is this Spirit, this breath, that is our source of life and new life - especially the life of holiness in God. It is this breath that gently blows us into friendship with God - in communion with Him through prayer and worship and service to others. This is the breath that is silently blowing in our hearts to transform us, heal us and rejuvenate us. It is He who sanctifies, inspires and consoles us and most especially assures us of His love that never leaves us.

Today, God assures us that He would never leave us and that through the Holy Spirit, He enters our hearts. He wanted to dwell in us. He wanted that we may have life with Him and have it to the full. This Spirit was given to us in our baptism and was strengthened in our confirmation. God, dwelling in us through His Spirit, inspires us and helps us to do His will, letting us feel His abiding presence and His love. It is the Spirit that moves us to love just as He loves that we may become holy.

All of us believe that the Holy Spirit works within us. I firmly believe that He is working in me when I administer the sacraments especially when I celebrate the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass. We feel God's presence in us because of His Spirit dwelling in us. Even if we do not see, hear, taste or smell the Holy Spirit, we do believe His existence. It is because "for those who believe in God, no explanation is necessary; for those who do not believe in God, no explanation is possible," (From the 1943 movie The Song of Bernadette).

May we always believe in the spirit of God that is continuously blowing us with His love that never leaves us and let us feel His mighty wind that makes us strong in our faith and His gentle breath that gives us life and lasting joy and peace.



My dearest friends in Christ,

Happy Birthday to all of you. This weekend we celebrate one of the most important feasts of our faith, the Pentecost - birthday of the Church. I wish you are all filled with the gift of the Holy Spirit to be stronger in faith and to hold fast to God's teachings.

I write you this message to confirm that as a servant of God and a priest of the holy Catholic Church, I vow by all means to be faithful to God's teachings and to his Church.

As you know, about three weeks ago, May 23, 2019, the California State Senate passed a bill – SB-360 that would require all Catholic priests to break the secret seal of confession, reporting child abuse cases confessed in the confessional. I agree that we all have to protect our children from abuses and I support laws to ensure the safety of minors. But when you propose a law that violates the law, the First Amendment, that law should not be complied with, for it is against the national constitution, the freedoms of religion.

I am 100% with our Bishop, Michael Barber, who wrote on CNA on May 29: "*I will go to jail before I will obey this attack on our religious freedom. Even if this bill passes, no priest may obey it. The protection of your right to confess to God and have your sins forgiven in total privacy must be protected. I urge you to contact your State Senator today to protest this bill.*"

I want to affirm with what our Bishop said: *I would rather go to jail than break the seal of confession.* I can't imagine saying this sentence again in this country of religious freedom. Growing up as a Catholic in a communist country where Christianity was badly persecuted, many times was I put in situations where I did say these words: "I would rather die than renounce my faith." There is no way they could force me to offend the Lord and his teachings.

My dear faithful parishioners, thank you for your commitment to the sacrament of reconciliation and trusting our priests. I noticed a big increase of people going to confession here at our church. This is truly a sign of the spiritual growth in our community. I just want to assure all of you that Fr. Chris and I, vowed to be faithful to God's commandments and comply with the teachings of his Church. We will never break the seal of confession. Thank you for your prayers and support.

P/S: *Per Canon Law, priests who violate the seal of confession by sharing anything learned within the sacramental context to anyone, at any time, for any reason, is subject to automatic excommunication and further punishments, including loss of the clerical state.*

Mis queridos amigos en Cristo,

Feliz cumpleaños a todos ustedes. Este fin de semana celebramos una de las fiestas más importantes de nuestra fe, Pentecostés-el cumpleaños de la Iglesia. Les deseo a todos, llenos del don del Espíritu Santo, ser más fuertes en la fe y aferrarse a las enseñanzas de Dios.

Les escribo este mensaje para confirmar que como siervo de Dios y sacerdote de la Santa Iglesia Católica, juro por todos los medios ser fiel a las enseñanzas de Dios y a su Iglesia.

Como saben hace tres semanas, el 23 de Mayo del 2019 el Senado del estado de California aprobó un proyecto de ley-SB-360 que reputaría a todos los sacerdotes Católicos romper el sello secreto de la confesión, reportando casos de abuso infantil confesado en el confesonario. Estoy de acuerdo en que todos tenemos que proteger a nuestros hijos de los abusos y apoyar las leyes para garantizar la seguridad de los menores. Pero cuando proponen una ley que viola la ley, la Primera Enmienda, esa ley no se debe cumplir, porque está en contra de las constituciones nacionales, las libertades de religión.

Yo estoy 100% con nuestro obispo Barber que escribió en la CNA el 29 de Mayo: "Iré a la cárcel antes de obedecer este ataque a nuestra libertad religiosa. Aunque este proyecto de ley pase, ningún sacerdote puede obedecerlo. La protección de su derecho a confesar a Dios y tener sus pecados perdonados en total intimidad debe ser protegida. Les insisto a ponerse en contacto con su Senador Estatal hoy para protestar por este proyecto de ley."

Quiero afirmar con lo que nuestro obispo dijo: *Prefiero ir a la cárcel que romper el sello de confesión.* No puedo imaginar que vuelva yo a decir esta frase en este país de una libertad religiosa. Al crecer como Católico en un país comunista donde el Cristianismo fue gravemente perseguido, muchas veces me puse en situaciones en las que dije estas palabras: "Yo prefiero morir que renunciar a mi fe." No hay manera de que me obliguen a ofender al Señor y sus enseñanzas.

Mis queridos fieles feligreses, gracias por el compromiso con el Sacramento de la reconciliación y la confianza hacia nuestros sacerdotes. Noté un gran aumento de personas que están lleno a confesarse aquí en nuestra Iglesia. Esto es verdaderamente un signo del crecimiento espiritual en nuestra comunidad. Sólo quiero asegurarles a todos que el Padre Chris y Yo, prometimos ser fieles a los mandamientos de Dios y cumplir con las enseñanzas de su Iglesia. Nunca romperemos el sello de confesión. Gracias por sus oraciones y apoyo.

P/S: Por Derecho Canónico, los sacerdotes que violen el sello de confesión compartiendo cualquier cosa aprendida en el contexto sacramental a cualquier persona, en cualquier momento, por cualquier motivo están sujetos a la excomunión automática y a otros castigos, incluida la pérdida del estado clerical.

Hoy, Dios nos asegura que Él nunca nos dejará y que por medio del Espíritu Santo, él entra en nuestros corazones. Quiere habitar en nosotros.
