Everyone of us wants to go to heaven and we hope that someday we will be in heaven. This very strong belief in us is clearly illustrated in today's Gospel (Lk. 20, 27-38). Jesus tells His disciples that the dead will rise again. Death is not the end. Our God is not a God of the dead, but of the living. Because of Christ and the Resurrection, we will be with God when our earthly life ends, and we will meet our departed relatives and friends again. This is the promise, and the challenge of the Resurrection. This is also the reason why we remember our deceased loved ones during this month.

I will be happy to embrace my father when I meet him again someday. He left this world in 2007. A lot of things have happened to me and to our family since then, and what a reunion it would be when we could talk and share again. Heaven is not impersonal and cold. On the contrary, it is a personal and warm homecoming with our Creator and with our departed loved ones.

Our earthly loves and relationships do not end in death. We will meet each other again in our best and purest form, minus the heartaches, minus issues, minus walls and divisions. There will be peace and rejoicing in heaven. But the highlight of our reunion in heaven is our reunion with our Creator. Over and above our joy of being reunited with our loved ones, our greatest joy will be that of being united with Him and in Him, finally.

But before our reunion with our loved ones in heaven, we should answer first the most important question: Are we prepared to enter that life beyond? How do we prepare for it?

One priest said that the problem is that, God who created us without asking our 'permission,' cannot bring us to the joy of heaven without our 'permission.' Our life here on earth is our preparation for that. How we live our lives here on earth would answer if we are prepared to enter heaven when we die. It lies on the decisions we make, in the thoughts that we nurture, in the words that we speak and in the actions that we do. In other words, do we live our lives responding to our call to holiness?

If our answer is 'YES,' then when our time will come to face death, we are assured that we face death as the doorway of our eternal home, our everlasting bliss with the Father if we live according to what He wanted us to live – to be holy as He is holy. One thing is for sure that we will die but death would not be that horrible, fearsome encounter but a way to meet our loving and merciful Father and forever dwell in His magnificent kingdom.

May we all go to heaven and with joy gaze the face of God in His heavenly kingdom at the end of our lives.
