

## 30th Sunday Ordinary Time

There are a lot of people who don't pray. Not just because they don't know or remember prayers, but because they think it's a waste of time. They may still believe in God, but they do not have a personal relationship with Him, because they think it has nothing to do with their lives. Pope Francis invites all believers to go out and meet those who do not yet know Jesus. Missionaries know from experience that the gospel of forgiveness and mercy can bring joy, reconciliation, justice, and peace."

The Pharisee of whom the gospel speaks of is the Pharisee of all times and we find it in all religions and in those who have no religion. The same applies to the figure of the publican, who is simply that of the sinner. The Pharisee is irreproachable before the law and therefore considered justified before God. His prayer of thanksgiving, rather than addressing God, is dedicated to himself. His God is legalism. The God of the Pharisee is in favor of the law and against sinners. Because he does not recognize himself as a sinner, but a just one, he does not receive God's forgiveness and justification. That is why he returns home with his sin, a sin aggravated by his prayer.

Instead, the publican prays as a publican, as a sinner. He stays behind, hits his chest and humbly asks for forgiveness before God. The publican stands before God and not before the law. He believes in a merciful God who welcomes the sinner. In his parable, Jesus spoke of that God that He makes present through the acceptance of sinners and eats with them. The publican, by recognizing himself as a sinner and asking for forgiveness, God forgives him, makes him a righteous person. He came home completely transformed. The Church, like Jesus, must be a sacrament of forgiveness and not condemnation.

St. Luke draws a general conclusion for his community. "Whoever exalts himself will be humbled, and the one who humbles himself will be exalted". It is undoubtedly living the humility that St. Teresa defined as "walking in truth". Humility has to do with the actual perception of our situation. It is not a foolish humility but a realistic recognition that we receive everything from God. We probably have superior qualities than many people, but that shouldn't lead us to despise others. We have neither deserved the gifts we received, nor are others guilty. God brings down the powerful from their thrones and extols the humble.

Let us pray: God our Father, whose Son became incarnate in our human lineage by stripping himself of his titles of glory and going through "one of many": teach us to walk in his footsteps, sincerely putting our hearts in His true glory: giving our lives humbly in love and service. We give you thanks for the example given to us by Jesus Christ, your Son, who lives and reigns with you, and walks with us, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, and is God for ever and ever. Amen.

## 30th Domingo Tiempo Ordinario

Hay muchas personas que no rezan. No sólo porque no saben o no recuerdan oraciones sino porque les parece una pérdida de tiempo. Es posible que todavía crean en Dios, pero no mantienen ninguna relación personal con Él, porque piensan que no tiene nada que ver con su vida. El Papa Francisco invita a todos los creyentes a salir e ir al encuentro de los que todavía no conocen a Jesús. Los misioneros saben por experiencia que el Evangelio del perdón y la misericordia pueden traer alegría, reconciliación, justicia y paz”.

El fariseo del que habla el evangelio es el fariseo de todos los tiempos y lo encontramos en todas las religiones y en los que no tienen religión. También acontece lo mismo con la figura del publicano, que es sin más la del pecador. El fariseo es irreprochable ante la ley y por eso se considera justificado ante Dios. Su oración de acción de gracias, más que dirigirse a Dios, está dedicada a sí mismo. Su Dios es el legalismo. El Dios del fariseo está a favor de la ley y en contra de los pecadores. Como no se reconoce pecador, sino justo, no recibe **el perdón** y la justificación de Dios. Por eso vuelve a casa con su pecado, pecado agravado por su oración. En cambio, el publicano reza como publicano, como pecador. Se mantiene atrás, se da golpes de pecho y pide humildemente perdón ante Dios. El publicano se sitúa ante Dios y no ante la ley. Cree en un Dios misericordioso que acoge al pecador. En su parábola, Jesús hablaba de ese Dios que Él hace presente a través de la acogida de los pecadores y comer con ellos. El publicano, al reconocerse pecador y pedir perdón, Dios lo perdona, hace de él una persona justa. Volvió a casa totalmente **transformado**. La Iglesia, como Jesús, debe ser sacramento de perdón y no condenación.

San Lucas saca una conclusión general para su comunidad. “El que se enaltece, será humillado, el que se humilla será enaltecido”. Se trata sin duda de vivir **la humildad** que Santa Teresa definía como “caminar en la verdad”. La humildad tiene que ver con la percepción real de nuestra situación. No se trata de una humildad tonta sino del reconocimiento realista de que todo lo recibimos de Dios. Probablemente tengamos cualidades superiores a muchas personas, pero eso no debe llevarnos a despreciar a los demás. Ni nosotros hemos merecido los dones recibidos, ni los demás son culpables. Dios derriba de sus tronos a los poderosos y ensalza a los humildes.

Oremos: Dios Padre Nuestro, cuyo Hijo se encarnó en nuestro linaje humano despojándose de sus títulos de gloria y pasando por "uno de tantos": enséñanos a caminar tras sus huellas, poniendo nuestro corazón sinceramente en la verdadera gloria: el dar nuestra vida humildemente en el amor y el servicio. Así te lo pedimos gracias al ejemplo que nos dio Jesucristo, tu Hijo, que contigo vive y reina, y camina con nosotros, en la unidad del Espíritu Santo, y es Dios por los siglos de los siglos. Amén.
