Humility

Friends, a major theme of this Sunday's Readings is about humility. The first reading says: *My child, conduct your affairs with humility, and you will be loved more than a giver of gifts. The more you humble yourself, the greater you are, and you will find favor with God.*

And in the Gospel, Jesus says: "When you are invited to a banquet, go and take the lowest place so that when the host comes to you he may say, 'My friend, move up to a higher position.' Then you will enjoy the esteem of your companions at the table. For every one who exalts himself will be humbled, but the one who humbles himself will be exalted." Humility- the door to holiness and salvation.

Unfortunately, humility is not an attractive virtue in this day and age. This word itself comes from the Latin "humus", which means, "soil"- thing we walk on, the foundation for everything. But who wants dirty and messy soil? Everybody wants diamonds and gold. But where do gold and diamonds come from? Soil. Just as soil is essential to our earthly existence, so also humility is to our soul. Yes, humility is not attractive, but is necessary for our salvation. It is the mother of many virtues from which obedience, reverence, patience, modesty, meekness and peace are born.

St. Augustine once said: If you asked me what are the easiest ways to heaven, I would tell you there are three best ways to get there. First is humility; the second is humility, and the third is humility. He is right. The gate to heaven is narrow (last Sunday's Gospel). If we don't bow down, we can't enter it. The problem in our society today is that people think they are the center of the universe, that they can do anything by themselves. After the construction of the Titanic, a reporter asked the builder how safe the ship would be. "Not even God can sink it," he answered. Well, God didn't have to sink it; an iceberg was enough. There is an old saying: there are two most important things in life: First there is God; second, I am not he. That is the only way to live this life as it is meant to be. So be humble so you may be exalted.

However, be aware of a fake humility. Humility can be a hidden pride like the arrogant person may say: *I am so proud that I am humble.* If you intentionally sit at the lowest place so that you can be taken up to the higher place, that's false humility. Being humble doesn't mean suppression of one's personal attributes. It doesn't consist of a beautiful woman calling herself ugly, or in an intelligent man calling himself stupid, otherwise it's false humility. The humble man knows his place and takes it. The humble man – if he is supposed to rule – rules; and when he is supposed to serve, serves. But even in his most triumphant moments, the humble man remembers that all he is, and all that he has, is from God. He does not mistake the gifts of God for his own sole achievement. That's what separates the humble from the proud.

So what is humility? Humility says, "I know who I am in God's eyes—And that's enough." May God, help us know ourselves as servants of God, learn to trust in Him and praise him forever and ever. Amen.





Humildad

Amigos, un tema importante de las Lecturas de este Domingo es la humildad. La primera lectura dice: Hijo mío, conduce tus asuntos con humildad, y serás amado más que un dador de regalos. Cuanto más te humilles, más grande eres, y encontrarás el favor de Dios. Y en el Evangelio, Jesús dice: "Cuando te inviten a un banquete, ve y toma el lugar más bajo para que cuando el anfitrión venga a ti pueda decir: 'Amigo mío, sube a una posición más alta'. Entonces disfrutarás de la estima de tus compañeros en la mesa. Porque todo aquel que se exalte será humillado, pero el que se humilla será exaltado." La humildad, la puerta a la santidad y a la salvación.



Desafortunadamente, la humildad no es una virtud atractiva en estos tiempos. Esta palabra en sí viene del latín "humus", que significa, "suelo", cosa sobre la que caminamos, la base de todo. Pero, ¿quién quiere tierra sucia y desordenada? Todo el mundo quiere diamantes y oro. Pero, ¿de dónde vienen el oro y los diamantes? del suelo. Así como la tierra es esencial para nuestra existencia terrenal, también la humildad es para nuestra alma. Sí, la humildad no es atractiva, pero es necesaria para nuestra salvación. Es la madre de muchas virtudes de las cuales nacen la obediencia, la reverencia, la paciencia, la modestia, la mansedumbre y la paz.

San Agustín dijo una vez: Si me preguntas cuáles son las formas más fáciles para llegar al cielo. Te diría que hay tres mejores maneras de llegar allí. Primero es la humildad; la segunda es la humildad, y la tercera es la humildad. El tuvo razón. La Puerta al cielo es estrecha (el Evangelio del Domingo pasado). Si no nos inclinamos, no podemos entrar en él. El problema de nuestra sociedad hoy en día es que la gente piensa que es el centro del universo, que puede hacer cualquier cosa por sí misma. Después de la construcción del Titanic, un reportero le preguntó al constructor: cuán segura sería la nave. "Ni siquiera Dios puede hundirla", respondió. Bueno, Dios no tenía que hundirla; un iceberg fue suficiente. Hay un viejo dicho: hay dos cosas más importantes en la vida: Primero está Dios; segundo, yo no soy Él. Es decir. Esa es la única manera de vivir esta vida tal como está destinada a ser. Así que sé humilde para que seas exaltado.

Sin embargo, se consciente de la falsa humildad. La humildad puede ser un orgullo oculto como la persona arrogante pudiese decir: Estoy tan orgulloso de ser humilde. Si intencionalmente asientes al lugar más bajo para que puedas ser llevado hasta el lugar más alto. Eso es falsa humildad. Ser humilde no significa la supresión de los atributos personales. No consiste en una mujer hermosa que se hace llamar fea, o en un hombre inteligente que se hace llamar estúpido de lo contrario es falsa humildad. El hombre humilde conoce su lugar y lo toma. El hombre humilde, si se supone que gobierna, gobierna; y cuando se supone que sirve, sirve. Pero incluso en sus momentos más triunfantes, el hombre humilde recuerda que todo lo que es, y todo lo que tiene, es de Dios. No confunde los dones de Dios con su único logro. Eso es lo que separa a los humildes de los orgullosos.

Entonces, ¿qué es la humildad? La humildad dice: "Sé quién soy a los ojos de Dios, y eso es suficiente". Que Dios nos ayude a conocernos a nosotros mismos como siervos de Dios, a aprender a confiar en él y a alabarla para siempre. Amén.
