WINTER COLD AND FLU SEASON

As we face the annual cold and flu season, complicated by concerns over the novel coronavirus, it is important that we all understand and promote healthy practices in our Parish. Therefore, we have made the decision not to offer the Blood of Christ at Communion, beginning this weekend and continuing throughout the cold and flu season. Please be reminded that receiving only one species means fully receiving Sacred Communion.

During this cold and flu season we would like to remind you also that those who are ill are not obligated to attend mass and should stay home to recover.

If you are feeling ill today, please refrain from offering your hand to others at the sign of peace.

HOW TO STAY HEALTHY

1. **Know the Facts:** Influenza is thought to spread mainly person-to-person through coughing or sneezing of infected people.
2. **Take Everyday Actions to Stay Healthy.**
3. **Cover your nose and mouth** with a tissue when you cough or sneeze or into your sleeve if no tissue is available. Throw the tissue away after you use it.
4. **Wash Your Hands Thoroughly and Often** with soap and water. If soap is not available, use an alcohol based hand rub.
5. **Avoid Touching Your Hands, Nose & Mouth.** Germs spread that way.
6. **Stay at Home if You Are Sick.** The CDC recommends you stay home from work or school and limit contact with others to keep from infecting them.
7. **Get Vaccinated.** Vaccination is the best protection we have against flu.

How can one sustain pain and suffering in life and still move forward? It is faith.

In the Gospel, Jesus brought Peter, John and James to a high mountain. This event of the Transfiguration of Jesus is an encouragement for them to go on as they follow Him. It is an inspiration for them to hold on to their faith. Whatever trials, sacrifices and sufferings they encounter, they would be able to surpass and overcome them when they stay close to Jesus. This is what fires them up and made them think to build three tents and stay on the mountain.

However, they have to go down. They have to face the daily realities of the cross and Calvary. Like us, we too have our ups and downs. We too wanted to stay in our ups, our high mountain. However, this is not the only reality in life. Life is not just a bed of roses. We also have our crosses to bear and sacrifices to make. This is the reason why Jesus did not stay on the mountain but went down and proceeded to Jerusalem where he would suffer and die for our sakes. We also have to come down with Jesus. We should not remain on the pedestal forever, on our mountains; instead we have to go down with Jesus and start the journey of service and sacrifice, of carrying our cross to Calvary that we may also rise with Him in the glory of resurrection, of a new life with Him.

Let us go down from our mountains with Jesus. Let us bring with us that faith in Him that would let us face our crosses and be able to forgive those who betrayed and turned away from us; accept those whom we ignore and avoid; love those whom we dislike and have hurt us; heal those who have wounded us; and help those who need us. Let us rise and carry our daily crosses and as Jesus said to Peter, James and John after the transfiguration, "Rise and do not be afraid!"

This Lenten Season, may we have faith in Jesus and continue to be with Him, carrying our cross with Him and at the end, share in the glory of His resurrection.

:Cómo se puede sostener el dolor y el sufrimiento en la vida y seguir avanzando? Es fe.

En el Evangelio, Jesús llevó a Pedro, Juan y Santiago a una montaña alta. Este acontecimiento de la Transfiguración de Jesús es un estímulo para que continúen a medida que lo siguen. Es una inspiración para que se aferren a su fe. Cualquiera que sean las pruebas, sacrificios y sufrimientos que encuentren, serían capaces de superarlos siempre si permanezcen cerca de Jesús. Esto es lo que los animó y les hizo pensar en construir tres tiendas de campaña y permanecer en la montaña.
