

Baptisms: In order to make baptismal arrangements contact carmen@goodshepherdpittsburg.org

Marriages: In order to make marriage arrangements contact carmen@goodshepherdpittsburg.org 6 months prior to marriage day.

Funeral Arrangements: Should be arranged by family, church and mortuary. Normal Christian burial consists of Vigil Service, Holy Mass and Burial in a Catholic Cemetery. Any other arrangements should first be discussed with parish priest.

After the many activities we had during Christmas, we come to the last day of the Christmas season, the Solemnity of the Lord's Baptism. Speaking of baptism, let us remember the day when we were baptized. Do you still remember the day of your baptism?

In today's Gospel (Mt. 3, 13-17), after Jesus was baptized by John, a voice came from heaven that said: "This is my Son, my Beloved!" These words express God's recognition that Jesus is indeed His Son and this happened during Jesus' baptism. Thus, we can also say that by virtue of our own baptism, we too have become sons and daughters in the Son. By the very same baptism, we too are called to live lives pleasing to the Father.

We who are baptized have become members of the church and members of Christ's Mystical Body. As members, we have privileges. But, as members we too have dues and duties. Please check your membership card today. There is no expiration date to our membership. It is permanent and indelible since the sacrament of baptism that we have received has an indelible mark. However, please check if you are still an active bona fide member, in good standing. By the way, our membership dues and duties are non-transferable, and cannot be delegated to others. Each one of us must do our mission. Baptism is our initiation for a mission.

A lot of people today carry the I-am-the-captain-of-my-soul stance, emphasizing heroic humanism without God. However, our stance is that of humility and obedience to someone greater than you and I, living a life anchored on God's vision and mission. Have we been faithful then to this mission given in our baptism?

We who have been baptized in our Lord Jesus Christ are reminded today of our baptismal promises to reject Satan, and to live lives pleasing to the Father and not only on an occasional basis. Let us remember our baptism today as we celebrate the Lord's baptism. Let us be reminded of our duties as baptized Catholics. Let us not forget that it is in our baptism that we gained back our broken relationship with God by washing away the stain of original sin. God constantly guides us and molds us that we may be holy as He is. And so, let us follow Jesus Himself that we may be worthy to be called and recognized by God as His sons and daughters.




