Followers

When Jesus learns that John the Baptist has been imprisoned, He leaves his village of Nazareth and marches to the shore of Lake Galilee to begin his mission. There's nothing spectacular about his first intervention. He doesn't perform a prodigy. Simply call some fishermen who respond immediately to their voice: "Follow me."

In that simple way, begins the movement of followers of Jesus. Here is the humble germ of what will one day be His Church. Here we are shown for the first time the relationship that must always be alive between Jesus and those who believe in Him. Before anything else, Christianity is, to live like Jesus Christ.

This means that the Christian faith is not only doctrinal adherence but conduct and life marked by our connection to Jesus. To believe in Jesus Christ is to live his way of life, encouraged by his Spirit, collaborating in His project of the kingdom of God and carrying His cross to share His resurrection.

Our temptation is always to want to be Christians without following Jesus, reducing our faith to a dogmatic affirmation or to a cult of Jesus as Lord and Son of God. However, the criterion for checking whether we believe in Jesus as the incarnate Son of God is to see if we follow Him alone.

Adherence to Jesus is not just about admiring Him as a man or worshipping Him as God. Those who admire or adore Him, staying out personally, without discovering in Him the demand to follow Him closely, do not live the Christian faith in an integral way. Only the one who truly follows Jesus can understand and live the Christian experience in an authentic way.

In today's Christianity we live in a paradoxical situation. The Church not only belongs to those who follow or attempt to follow Jesus, but also those who do not care at all about walking in their footsteps. It is enough to be baptized and not to break communion with the institution, to officially belong to the Church of Jesus, even if the person has never set out to follow him.

The first thing we must hear from Jesus in our Church is His call to follow Him unreservedly, freeing us from bonds, cowardly and deviations that prevent us from walking after Him. These times of crisis may be the best opportunity to correct the way we live Christianity and help the Church move in the direction of Jesus.

We must learn to live dynamically in our Christian communities and groups, with our eyes fixed on Jesus, following in His footsteps and collaborating with Him in humanizing life. We will enjoy our faith in a new way.

Seguidores

Cuando Jesús se entera de que Juan el Bautista ha sido encarcelado, abandona su aldea de Nazaret y marcha a la ribera del lago de Galilea para comenzar su misión. Su primera intervención no tiene nada de espectacular. No realiza un prodigio. Sencillamente, llama a unos pescadores que responden inmediatamente a su voz: "Seguidme".

Así comienza el movimiento de seguidores de Jesús. Aquí está el germen humilde de lo que un día será su Iglesia. Aquí se nos manifiesta por vez primera la relación que ha de mantenerse siempre viva entre Jesús y quienes creen en Él. El cristianismo es, antes que nada, vivir como Jesucristo.

Esto significa que la fe cristiana no es sólo adhesión doctrinal, sino conducta y vida marcada por nuestra vinculación a Jesús. Creer en Jesucristo es vivir su estilo de vida, animados por su Espíritu, colaborando en su proyecto del reino de Dios y cargando con su cruz para compartir su resurrección.

Nuestra tentación es siempre querer ser cristianos sin seguir a Jesús, reduciendo nuestra fe a una afirmación dogmática o a un culto a Jesús como Señor e Hijo de Dios. Sin embargo, el criterio para verificar si creemos en Jesús como Hijo encarnado de Dios es comprobar si le seguimos sólo a Él.

La adhesión a Jesús no consiste sólo en admirarlo como hombre ni en adorarlo como Dios. Quien lo admira o lo adora, quedándose personalmente fuera, sin descubrir en Él la exigencia a seguirle de cerca, no vive la fe cristiana de manera integral. Sólo el que verdaderamente sigue a Jesús puede entender y vivir la experiencia cristiana de forma auténtica.

En el cristianismo actual vivimos una situación paradójica. A la Iglesia no sólo pertenecen los que siguen o intentan seguir a Jesús, sino, además, los que no se preocupan en absoluto de caminar tras sus pasos. Basta estar bautizado y no romper la comunión con la institución, para pertenecer oficialmente a la Iglesia de Jesús, aunque jamás se haya propuesto seguirle.

Lo primero que hemos de escuchar de Jesús en nuestra Iglesia es su llamada a seguirle sin reservas, liberándonos de ataduras, cobardías y desviaciones que nos impiden caminar tras Él. Estos tiempos de crisis pueden ser la mejor oportunidad para corregir nuestra forma de vivir el cristianismo y ayudar a la Iglesia a moverse en dirección hacia Jesús.

Hemos de aprender a vivir en nuestras comunidades y grupos cristianos de manera dinámica, con los ojos fijos en Jesús, siguiendo sus pasos y colaborando con Él en humanizar la vida. Disfrutaremos de nuestra fe de manera nueva.
